

Mooted Farm Aid Changes May Increase Immigration

Possibility of a heavier flow of immigrants from the Netherlands is seen if proposed provincial legislation changing the terms under which farmers may receive government financing on farm purchases is passed.

In the province today to look over the situation is Jan Athmer, fiscal vice-counsel for emigration affairs, of the Netherlands Consulate General, Montreal.

Yesterday the vice-consul called on Premier Walter R. Shaw as provincial minister of agriculture to discuss various aspects of farm immigration here of Dutch farmers.

Prior to his talk with the Premier he briefly reviewed the situation in agriculture in Holland. He noted in his homeland the farms are small and are becoming fewer as industry and home building take more and more of the land.

He frankly displayed his interest in Dutch farmers here and in possibilities of settling more in this province. He said young farmers in The Netherlands had no opportunity to buy farms at home and on emigrating had little money with which to purchase them here.

IMMIGRANTS PLEASED

He said other Dutch immigrants to this province were pleased with conditions here but too often found themselves unable to obtain financial assistance to purchase farms due to their age.

The present provincial legislation limits aid to young farmers between the ages of 21 and 35.

Mr. Athmer said a majority of immigrants preferred to work on farms here for the first few years in order to familiarize themselves with the soil, crop conditions and other circumstances surrounding farm operations.

This working period permitted them to save some money from their wages and thus give them a start towards purchasing their own farms.

NO INTEREST IN SHORE

He said they were, not particularly interested in what are known as "shore" farms because they have no concern with fishing.

Farm Scientists Are On Hunt For Septoria Resistant Oats

Extensive experiments are going on at the Charlottetown Experimental Farm in an effort to find varieties of oats which are resistant to the disease known as "septoria".

Septoria is a fungus which causes leaf blotching and straw rotting in oats, resulting in breakage of the straw just before harvesting.

The result is a loss in both yield and quality of the grain.

Working as a team in this project are Bruce MacLaren and Dick Stirling. It is their job to find, through the process of cross breeding, a variety of oats that will be resistant to the fungus.
