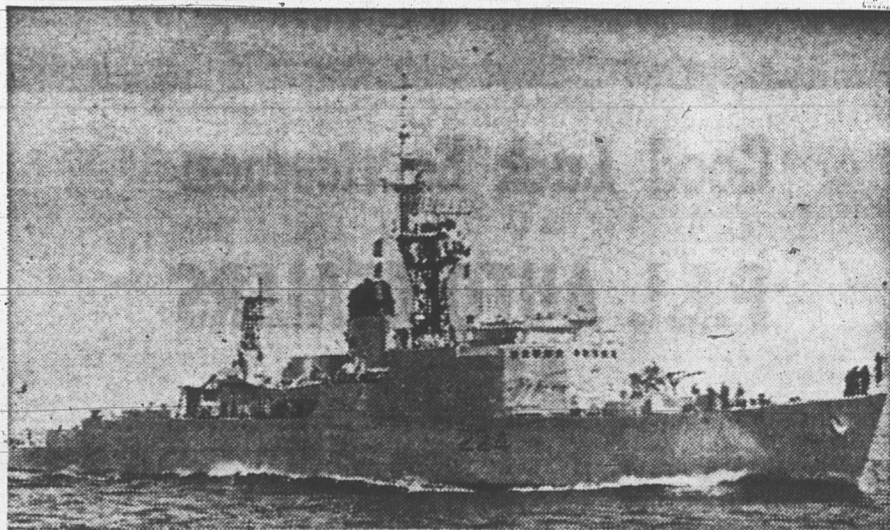

Seabrook Farms Frozen Foods Ltd., the P.E.I., and only Canadian plant of Seabrook Farms Co., is now in its sixth packing season, having begun production in October of 1961. The New Annan plant is in year-round operation and employs 375 to 400 persons during the summer months and a minimum of 100 during the winter, with the total annual payroll being in the vicinity of \$500,000.

The plant's raw material requirements are met by P.E.I.'s best growers, all located within 5 to 15 miles of the plant.

The local plant processes nationally, six products, namely, spinach, peas, broccoli, cauliflower, brussel sprouts and potatoes, which find major markets in Ontario and Quebec with an ever increasing sale in the Maritimes and the United Kingdom. The firm also markets green beans, corn, mixed vegetables, carrots and lima beans which at present are packed in affiliated plants throughout Canada. Some of the above may be introduced into P.E.I. production in the future. These products are marketed under the following well known Brand names SEABROOK FARMS, SNOW-CROP, P.E.I. POTATOES, FLEUR DE LYS, COTCH MAID AND SOMERDALE.
