

# Lipstick colors are vivid

From fashion to flowers—everything bursts forth with color when spring appears. Vivid and exciting is the word for color this spring, everywhere they are mixing, and mating color in dramatic combinations.

Art and beauty authority Helene Rubinstein, creates a new spring look that she calls the "Color Collage". She took her cue from her famous art gallery. Her collection of Collages by well-known modern artists reveal a brilliant combination of color fragments and materials skillfully blended into works of art.

Madame Rubinstein's Color Collage look is created in makeup with a technique called "color-lining color". Color is used in two's and three's, one blending into the other.

Lips are outlined with one color and filled in with another. You may contrast an orange liner with a pink to fill in, an easy effect to achieve with the new slim Fashion Stick lipstick that lines and colors in one operation.

"Collage" your eyes by choosing an eye shadow stick in a deep color, such as turquoise, to draw a thin line next to the lashes, and ending in an extended stroke at the outer corner of the eye. Next, a second, and a lighter color, such as star sapphires lines the first line just above it, ending in a slight up-sweep before the outer corner so that you have two "wings" of color. For added definition, use a brush to apply eye shadow.

Skin tones should be light as an artist's canvas, to point up the highlights of the eyes and mouth. The perfect matte complexion is attained with cover fluid in either rosate, ivory or the mauve shades.

Still a third hue may be added to the eye scheme with one of the fashion colors of marmaromatic in royal blue, used on the lashes. Use a brush to add feathers of color from your marmaromatic to the wing of the eyebrow!

Makeup that enhances, entrances, and accents—with a skillful blending of several colors is no accident! It is the delicate application of professional skill. You too can become an artist by using these professional tips—

(1) Outline your lips in a darker lipstick to make the lips fuller, then fill in with a lighter lipstick.

(2) Too full lips? Outline in a lighter shade, fill in with a darker one—and, a special reminder for evening wear. Adjust your make-up to the light in which you wear it. Daylight reveals color—artificial light drains color. So—at night use more make-up on the eyes, pickier foundation and powder, and a deeper lipstick.

# There'll be no sneakers in Easter parade for '62

For the first time in several years there will be no sneakers in the Easter parade. Teenagers, who have been wearing canvas tennis shoes for all occasions, even the most inappropriate, are on a new kick this year—colorful leather shoes.

The reason teen girls are leaving sneakers to the gym floor and the tennis court from which they came is that the beat and kookie look is giving way on the campus to the demure, feminine air. New developments in leathers such as brilliantly-hued patent leather and new styles like the strap-up, sophisticated many-jane pump are responsible for this new teen trend, says Shoe Fashion Service of Leather Industries.

In flat or pump, the new patent leather shoe is an eye-dar. Made by a new process that combines longer life with a brighter sheen, this spring's patent leathers include butter-

cup yellow, brilliant coral, electric blue and deep green.

Some of the dressier pumps are seen in aniline dyed patent which is finished to preserve the natural markings of the hide and add another, beautiful fashion dimension to a youthful pump. Of course, brilliant black and washable white patent leather shoes will also claim and slimmer as you walk down a sunlit street. Smooth, lightweight leather linings keep your feet cool, dry and comfortable all day long.

The multi-colored shoe—with two or more colors and leather textures—is another teen favorite. On a low or pancake heel, the smooth or grained leather dress pump sports porbables and an elastic collar. For casual wear, you will find it in brushed or grained leather flats.

# Style trend seen secret of women's longer lives

TORONTO—A woman's fashion trend is helping save the feminine population from the "great epidemic disease" of 20th century, Dr. Jeremiah Stamler, director of the City of Chicago heart disease control program, told a recent public meeting on atherosclerosis here.

"Women want to be slim," he said. "This desire has become the style for women but is only beginning to become the style for most doctors. Slim people are much less likely than fat ones to develop atherosclerosis, a disease that brings about coronary heart disease and strokes, he said. Women's special hormones also give a measure of protection.

"The sex ratio of coronaries before the age of 45 is about 20 men to every one woman," Dr. Stamler told the Canadian Association for the Prevention of Atherosclerosis.

After 45—- the age of the menopause—- women become more subject to heart attacks. They are producing less estrogen, a hormone which gives them protection.

Dr. Stamler said he is just completing a 10-year study of estrogen. While final figures are not in, he said it is possible to reduce heart disease in men by administering estrogen. But it has an undesirable feminizing influence.

NEW YORK (AP)—Women may provide the ultimate answer to the acute shortage of engineers for aerospace and missile work, says William Howe, chief regional recruiter for the National Aeronautics and Space Administration.

"We're definitely trying to interest high school and college girls in engineering," he said in an interview Monday. Howe and scores of talent-hunters from private segments of the aerospace and electronics industries have joined in an elaborate project for interviewing engineers assembled here for the 1962 convention of the Institute of Radio Engineers.
