

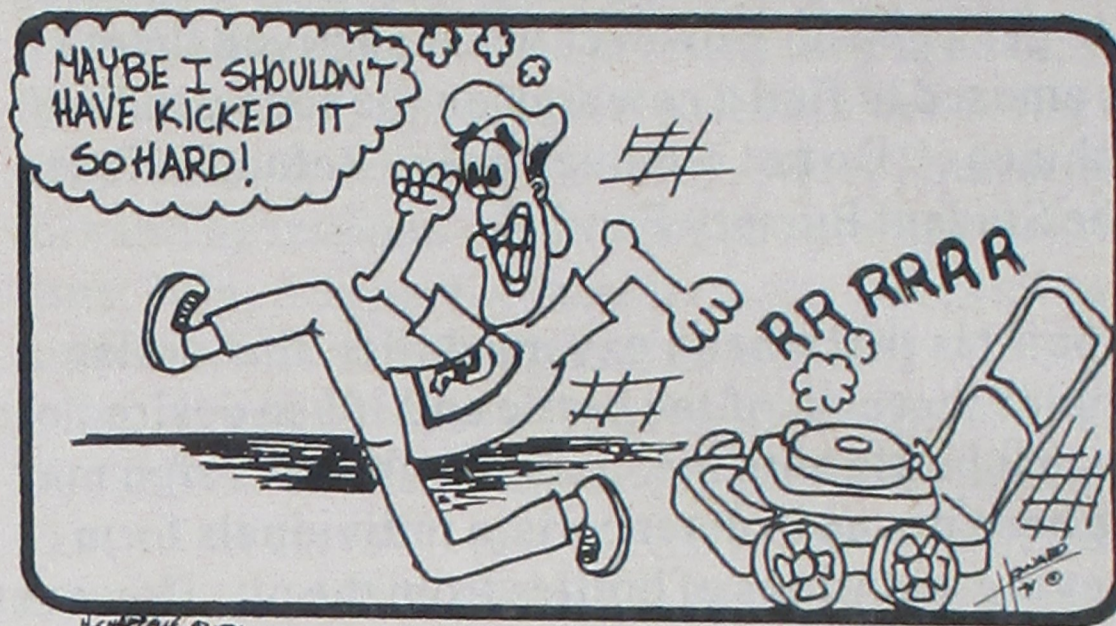
Campus Coffee Opens

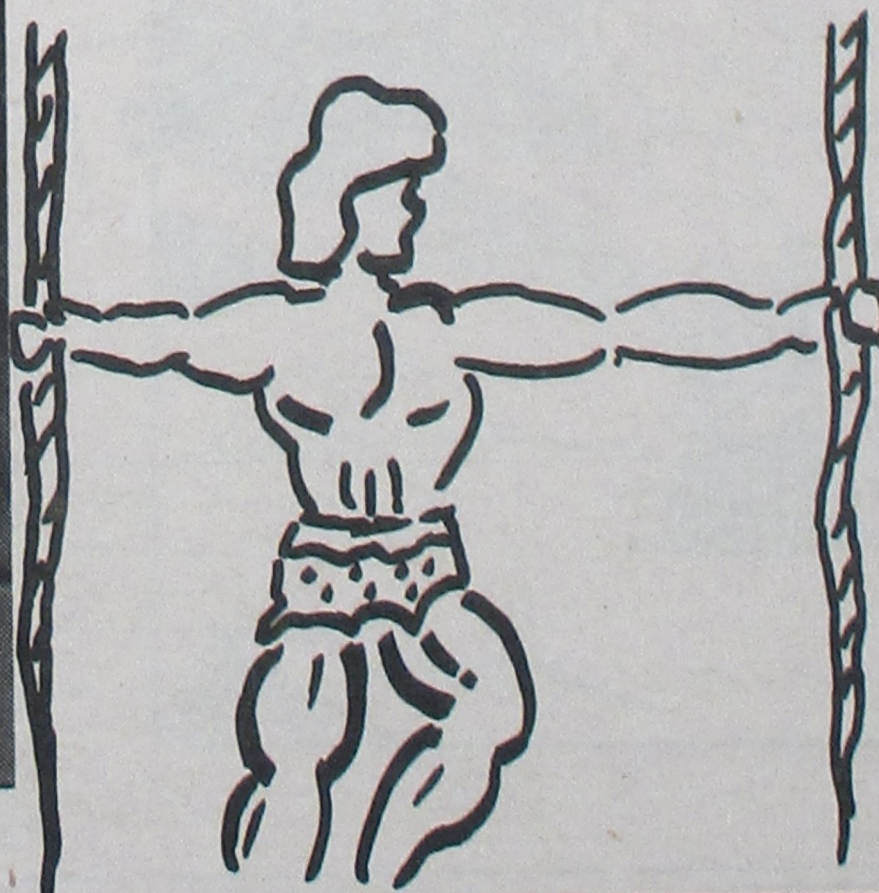
