The Great Engineering Strike.

LONDON, Oct. 12.—The Secretary of the federated trades comprising thirty important industries, announces that the executive committee has decided to call out all its members in sympathy with the struggle of engineers' against the employers. On Friday next when it is estimated that a total of four hundred thousand will be out of work on account of the great labor dispute. The strike is assuming proportions without parallel and no one can now foresee its consequence.

The Irish Independent League.

DUBLIN, Oct. 12.—The first general National Conference of the Irish Independent League, organized by John Redmond, M. P., Parnellite leader, opened this afternoon in the ancient concert room. Eight hundred delegates packed the hall and actively participated in cheering vociferously every point in the speeches. Redmond characterized Gladstone as "The Englishman who betrayed Ireland."

HALIFAX, Oct. 11.—The tenth annual Convention of the Nova Scotia Sunday School Association met at Park St. Church last evening. There were present some sixty delegates and more came to-day. Professor Hamill was present. After this Convention he leaves for P. E. Island.

A Railway Sold.

HALIFAX, Oct. 12.—The Inverness and Richmond Railway has been sold to a Syndicate of Ontario and Chicago capitalists headed by P. Ryan of Toronto.

NEW YORK, October 10.—A London despatch to the Times to-day says: "The sultan begins his preparations for evacuating Thessaly by sending 20,000 fresh troops of the line thither. The shipping of these soldiers, all picked battalions, drawn nearly from Asia, had been proceeding busily all the week."

BRISTOL, Eng. October 10.—The municipality of this city proposes to construct a new dock, which will occupy an area of forty acres, and also a large graving dock and grain sheds, the works to cost upwards of \$7,500,000. Parliamentary authorization for the improvements will be sought at the next session.

DUBLIN, Oct. 10.—Today was the sixth anniversary of the death of Charles Stewart Parnell. Five thousand nationalists paraded the streets to the cemetery, where they heaped high the grave of the famous and lamented leader with flowers from all the counties of Ireland. There were more than thirty bands in line. No Union Jacks were carried but nearly every country delegation raised the stars and stripes next to the green flag. There was no disturbance. There was no speech asking.

BUFFALO, N. Y., Oct. 10.—A special to the Evening News from Bridgeport, Conn., says that the government strongly anticipates serious trouble with Spain, but that the latter will be backed by some European power, probably Germany, is shown by the notification sent by Secretary Sherman to the owners of a number of the largest steamships and steam yachts on the Atlantic coast, asking for immediate information as to speed, capacity and fighting strength of their vessels, and for other complete data, with a view to their being enrolled as auxiliary cruisers of the navy. The further request was made, the Morning Union learns on good authority, that the owners held themselves in readiness to turn their vessels over to the government at a moment's notice, on intimation being given that a use will be found for them very shortly. One of the ships which the government intends to turn into a warship is the John Eagles, Capt. Bragg, of the Portland Line.
