Notice of Opening for Positions on the UPEI Student

Nominations open Monday September 25 at 9:00 AM and will close Friday September 29 at 12:00 PM.

The following council positions will be open for contention in the October 10, 11, and 12, 1989 election.

Arts Representative 1	Are you interested in this position?
Board of Governors Representative 1	Do you want to be part of the decision making process?
Education Representative 1	Do you want to be part of the decision making process?
Veterinary Medicine 1	Do you want to be part of the decision making process?
Freshman Representative 1	Do you want to be part of the decision making process?
Senate 3	Do you want to be part of the decision making process?

Nomination Procedure

A. Each candidate is required to file a nomination form with the Chief Returning Officer (CRO) by the closing of nominations. The form is to contain the candidate's name, address, faculty, year, desired position, and the signatures and student numbers of ten (10) active members of the UPEI Student Union within that person's constituency. It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that the signatures are all active members of the UPEI SU.

B. By signing the nomination form, the candidate agrees to abide by the Elections and Referenda By-Law of the UPEI Student Union, or accept the outlined consequences.

C. The CRO must validate each nomination form with his/her signature after ensuring the eligibility of the candidate to run. This validation must be done within twenty-four (24) hours of closing of nominations.

D. The CRO shall preside at a nomination meeting no more than twenty-four (24) hours after the closing of nominations and at that time shall announce the roster of candidates found eligible to run. All candidates, or others carrying a written statement by the candidate naming them as official representatives, MUST attend this meeting, which will outline election procedures. Failure to attend this meeting or to send a representative results in disqualification of the candidate by the CRO.

E. If no eligible candidates have come forward to run for a position by the close of nominations, the CRO shall reopen nominations for that position for a period of one (1) week from the close of the first nominations.

F. If only one (1) eligible candidate is nominated for a position he/she shall not be declared acclaimed, but shall campaign for the designated period and shall have his/her candidacy tested by a "yes/no/abstain" vote of the constituency. The total number of yes votes must be greater than the 50% plus one (1) of the votes cast, for the candidate to be declared elected.

G. At the nominations meeting the CRO must both read aloud and distribute written copies of the election procedures to the candidates or their representatives, to ensure that all candidates are cognizant with their responsibilities during the election and the implications of any infractions they commit.

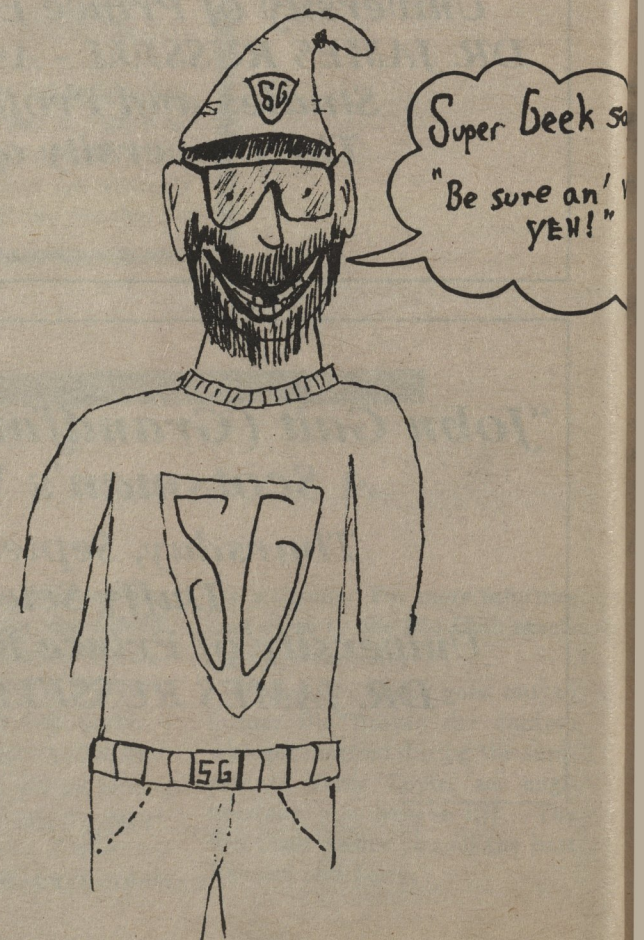
