



**NEW PARTY
MAKES DEBUT**

TORONTO (CP)—A new political party made its debut here but only 14 persons attended the proclamation of its manifesto and two of them walked out before the end of the meeting.

Frederic Reiner, a 54-year-old construction superintendent and founder of the New Canada and North American Union party, called for abolition of federal elections and an end to the British Crown's sovereignty in Canada.

Mr. Reiner claims federal elections are a waste of money. He wants provincial elections only, with each province sending a specified number of representatives to Ottawa to form a central government.

**Terrorists
In Caracas
Seize Plane**

CARACAS, Venezuela (AP)—Terrorists from a Venezuelan airline and forced it down on Trinidad Thursday in the rising pro-Communist campaign to overthrow President Romulo Betancourt's government.

Venezuela promptly called for return of both the plane and the terrorists — five men and a woman who surrendered to Trinidad authorities on landing at Port of Spain, in the Caribbean 300 miles east of Caracas. In a related development, Betancourt's government had charged Cuba with aggression, saying Cuba was the source of a three-ton cache of arms found buried on a sandy beach of Falcon state Nov. 3. It urged other Latin American nations to back a Venezuelan protest to the Organization of American States.

Caracas police hunted vainly for a U.S. army officer, Lt.-Col. James K. Chenault of Sherman, Texas, who was kidnapped Wednesday by persons identifying themselves as members of the outlawed Armed Forces of National Liberation. But the kidnapers promised to free Chenault Saturday. A woman telephoned newspapers 12 a.m. she spent a comfortable night and "is enjoying himself."

**Fine Inposed
For Selling
Lottery Ticket**

LONDON, Ont. (CP) — Earl Emerson Knott of nearby Niles town, who disposed of an Irish Hospital sweepstakes ticket that won \$100,000 for a London woman earlier this year, was fined \$100 Thursday after he pleaded guilty to a charge of disposing of lottery tickets.

Court was told by morality officer Joseph Summerlin that Knott received \$1,500 for disposing of the winning ticket to Mrs. Marion Pollard. The race was run in June. The officer testified that Knott admitted to him in an interview that he purchased a ticket for Mrs. Pollard. Mrs. Pollard paid Knott for the ticket the night of the race, court was told. A charge of selling lottery tickets was withdrawn by the prosecution.

Knott was one of several persons charged with sweepstakes offences in western Ontario this year. Fines handed out by Magistrate Donald B. Menzies so far have gone well over the \$40,000 mark.

OTTAWA (CP) — Central Montreal Housing Corporation has awarded a \$1,070,705 contract for construction of a 105-unit federal-provincial low-rental housing project at Moncton, N.B. It was announced Thursday.

Under terms of the contract to Community Enterprises Limited of Halifax work will begin immediately for completion by Nov. 15, 1964.

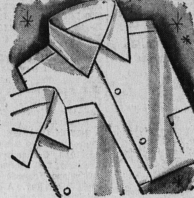

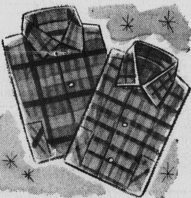

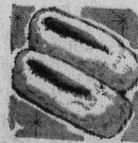
