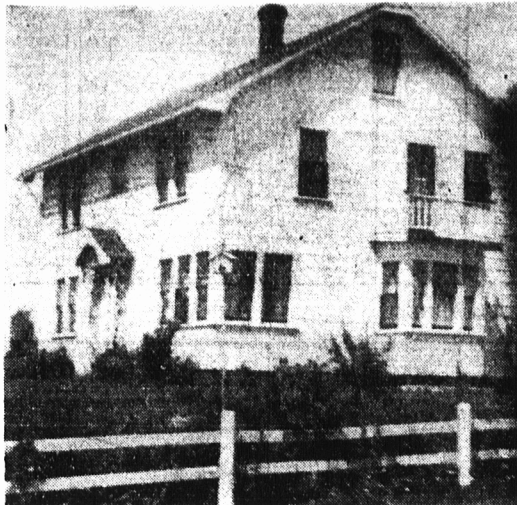

N. Y. Stocks At Highest Point In 22 Years

NEW YORK, Aug. 10 (AP) - Quiet selective strength sent the stock market last week into high ground for the year.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks reached its highest point in more than 22 years at \$109.80. Strength came largely from the railroads which have been outstanding market leaders for some time.

Buying confidence in the cariers was based on recent highly favorable earnings reports. Chrysler showed unexpected good earnings in the first half and the stock immediately went to a high for the year, carrying the rest of the motors along with it.

The five most active issues on the stock exchange last week were American Telephone up 5-8 at 155, American Bosch up 5-8 at 15 1-4, General Motors up 1 1-2 at 61 3-8, the Milwaukee Road up 1 at 22 1-8, and Serval Inc. up 1 at 9 5-8.

Canadian issues were mostly higher Friday. Canadian Pacific added 1-4, International Nickel added 1-8 while Dome Mines, McIntyre and Seagrams were unchanged.

On the Curb, Lake Shore slipped 1-8. Giant Yellowknife and Royal Oil both remained unchanged.

U.S. Steel Report

CLEVELAND, Aug. 10 (AP) - The United States steel industry, making rapid production gains, will hit its pre-strike operating rate within the next two weeks. Steel magazine predicted today.

Last week the country's ingot-operating rate rose 42 points to 85 per cent of capacity, or 1,765,484 net tons of ingots. This was the highest weekly output since the last week in May when 2,091,000 tons were produced.

Despite these gains, Steel said, there are no indications of a general easing in supply conditions before next spring. Shortages threaten in all the major steel products in the coming months, especially for civilian consumers.
