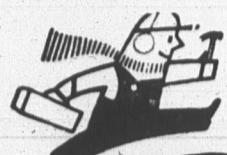
## Public Accounts Committee Studying Doctor's Bills

OTTAWA (CP)—Brigaw J. Lawson, judge advocate general of the armed forces, said the government probably saved money when it accepted a \$2,500 out-of-court settlement of a defence department claim for more than \$4,000 against an armed forces doctor who charged dependents for medical treatment.

The case was reported by Auditor-General Maxwell Henderson in his 1965 report to the Commons, now being studied by the public accounts committee.

The doctor — who was not named in the report or committee discussion — joined the armed forces before completing his medical school studies under a plan by which the defence department paid him a salary

## Medical Centres In Firms Become Preventive Clinics

MONTREAL (CP) — Medical departments in Canadian companies have made rapid advances in recent years and are

centres to clinics of preventive medicine, says the president of the Quebec Industrial Medical Association.

"The evolution of industrial medicine from first aid to prevention is comparable to that of transport from the wheel barrow to the jet plane," Dr. G. Earle Birney said in an interview here.

Because of a possible conflict of interests it is rare for a company to make treatment for illness available to its staff—the family doctor puts his patients first while the industrial doctor may be too aware of his company's interests.

"The personal doctor prescribes, the company doctor decides," is the way Dr. Wright puts it. He is medical chief of Canadian Pacific Railways and Canadian Pacific Airlines.

But prevention of illness can be very much the concern of the company doctor.

"We want to put more stress on prevention of ill health in industry," says Dr. Donald C. Bews of Montreal, president of the Industrial Medical Association and medical director of Bell Telephone of Canada.

### LAUSCH PROGRAM

Bell Telephone and the Northern Electric Company have recently launched a joint program for early diagnosis of lung cancer in male employees.

The value of programs like the Bell-Northern survey is that certain diseases, such as lung cancer, can be cured only if caught early. In men lung cancer is the most common kind of fatal cancer.

For the company the test is relatively simple. The subject spends up to 20 minutes breathing in mildly-medicated steam and then is able to cough up sputum for examination in a hospital pathology department.

Dr. Wright says in many firms the medical department gives valuable assistance during the planning stages of a new plant, advising on health factors such as lighting and air conditioning.

Environmental studies have helped in cutting down the number of atmospheric contaminants which affect employees.

Voluntary periodic examinations, either in the firm's medical department or by referral to outside clinics, are becoming more common.

Not common enough, however, for Dr. Bews.

"Any firm with more than 500 employees can benefit from such a service," he says.

### SAYS ILLNESS COSTLY

"A company that size that says it is not big enough yet just doesn't know how much sickness is costing them."

Dr. Bews is the first Canadian to be elected president of the Industrial Medical Association—a joint Canadian-U.S. organization—and feels his appointment reflects the high standard of occupational medicine in Canada.

He is also one of a handful of Canadians who are certified as specialists in occupational medicine.

Medicare, whatever form it takes, will not do away with the necessity for company medical departments, Dr. Bews feels.

"Companies will still be interested in prevention of illness, and maintenance of health, not to mention first aid."

Dr. Bews says that in Britain, under the National Health Service, industrial medicine has proved to be stronger than ever.

### INVESTIGATE ARMS MIX-UP

LEOPOLDVILLE (Reuters)—An official investigation was ordered Saturday into an apparent mix-up in which Congolese government troops Friday night raided a government arms store, sources close to President Joseph Mobutu said. A Belgian officer and two mercenaries were detained for questioning following the raid on one of the city's largest apartment buildings when 32 cases of arms and ammunition were seized. But sources said that the three men were in fact employed by the government to round up arms held by civilians in the area.

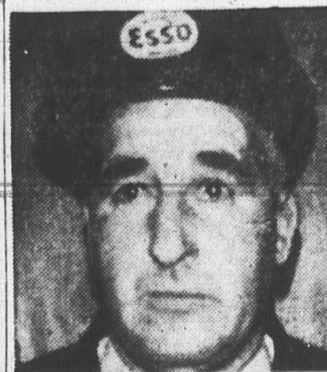
