WASHINGTON AP—NATO nations could save up to half the cost and a year in construction time by using converted merchant ships instead of submarines as Polaris missile bases.

The U.S. Navy, which once strongly urged replacing Polaris missiles in cruiser hulls, has in its files extensive cost analyses and a variety of blueprints.

After the first such conversion, they estimated, the cost would drop to about \$38,000,000. By contrast, a polaris submarine costs about \$120,000,000.

From a standing start, the navy engineering studies indicate, it would take about two years to complete a surface ship conversion, perhaps a year less than needed to turn out a Polaris submarine.

Macmillan, who was answering questions in the House of Commons, said the Polaris warheads "will be British and there will be no question" of attaching any United States mechanism to them.
