

Professor Sentenced

A UPEI prof. was sentenced to 10 months in jail on Friday Oct 4.

Professor Arthur Garfield Webster of St. Peters Bay was found guilty by Madam Justice Jacqueline R. Matheson on Oct 4/91

The conviction follows charges that between Sept 1/72 and Dec 31/77 Webster was trafficking in narcotics (cannabis resin, hash, and cannabis marijuana)

Webster was found guilty of supplying drugs to three children ranging in age from 9 to 11 and continuing to supply the children up to their teens

The following is from the transcript of the Supreme court Trial

Dec 7/1190

Her Majesty the Queen
vs
Arthur Garfield Webster

-Crown Witness: The first drugs that I was introduced to was weed. When I was about ten years old.

-Crown: What can you remember about the first time that you consumed those narcotics?

-Witness: Well I remember smoking them with Mr. Webster.

-Crown: Mr. Webster, is that Arthur Garfield Webster?

-Witness: Yeah

-Crown: And you'd be obtaining hash from other individuals besides Mr. Webster?

-Witness: Yeah

Professor Webster appealed and was released on Oct 15 awaiting the appeal decision.
