At the time of Rommel's dramatic successes in North Africa a visitor to the British Headquarters complained about the attitude of the officers there. Their one topic of conversation was: "What will Rommel do next? Where will he strike? But never a word about what the Allies ought to do."

There always rocks and shoals awaiting the ship adrift. Has not the Christian church, as well as the free nations, been content to stand on the defensive? This is the more excusable because of the resources at the command of faith and because of the urgency of the need for the leadership which spiritual forces alone can give.

The same nations have been following the same policy with Hitler's successor in ambition for world-conquest. They have watched Russia building up Communist armies in East Germany, and have been wondering what they could do when these forces attacked the West.

Not only do the nations require spiritual leadership, but science is calling for the co-operation of religion. There was a time when on religious issues science was neutral, at best, and sometimes hostile.

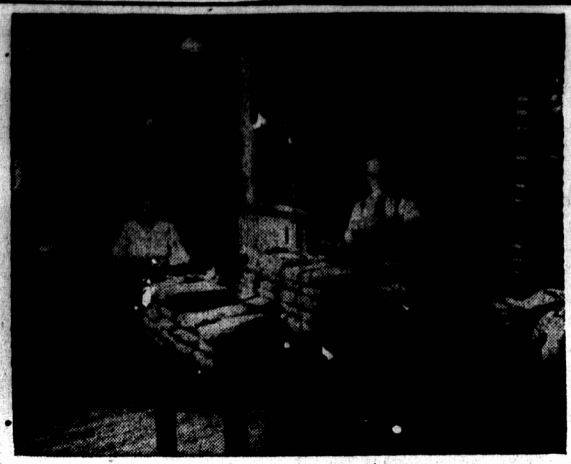
