Canadians Asked To Aid Indian Food Project

OTTAWA (CP) - Canadians are being asked to contribute \$300,000 to help establish a centre at Mysore, India, for the training of Asians in the processing, packaging and storage of essential foods and gas.

Funds for the centre will be raised jointly by the government of India and the Canadian Freedom from Hunger committee, partly through the sale of ball-point pens - "write off hunger in Asia."

Joseph H. Hulse, national chairman of the committee, announced here following a meeting with Prime Minister Pearson that the week starting Sept. 19 has been officially declared Canada - Mysore week.

"I think the declaration of Canada - Mysore week is a fitting way of marking this worthwhile endeavor," Mr. Pearson said. "The project will give Canadians the opportunity of making a significant contribution to the development of the countries of South Asia, and I am sure that it will receive generous support."

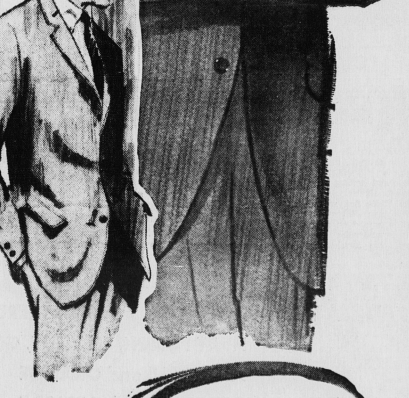
