**Queens MP Foresees Support For Federal Education Aid**

OTTAWA — The government will find support for any move to assist young people to attain their educational goals, Health Macquarrie MP for Queens, said in the Commons here.

Mr. Macquarrie recently returned to Ottawa following a trip which took him to a number of Canadian universities and he said that a person cannot make such a trip without being impressed with the tremendous needs, financial and otherwise, that face university administrators.

He said that the representation made by the Canadian Teachers' Federation and the Canadian University Foundation must be met by the government with more than just an agreeable verbal response.

He urged that a shared program on education should be devised although the fundamental and prime role of the provinces in the field would have to be recognized.

"I come from one of those provinces which are never terribly concerned about joint ventures in which the dominant government participates. We have no worries about our provincial purity as long as we can find some means to assist in meeting the needs of our people," Mr. Macquarrie said.

He expressed the hope the government would move quickly on its pledge to provide 10,000 scholarships of \$1,000 each for young people and of various plans for bursaries and other loan assistance to students.

The P.E.I. member reminded the Commons that in a few days the province would be starting its observance of the 100th anniversary of the Charlottetown conference that led to confederation.

"I would not presume to say that we in P.E.I. can teach all of Canada how to conduct celebrations, but I would suggest that any Canadian who comes to these would learn a great deal," Mr. Macquarrie said.
