WINNIPEG, (CP)—Prices on the Winnipeg grain exchange followed the irregular trend of American markets Monday but were firmer towards the close. Moderate commercial demand was noted. There were export purchases in all coarse grains. Small parcels of feed barley and feed oats were reported sold to the United Kingdom. Modest rye sales went to Holland. Some flax trade was attributed to seaboard and industrial accounts. There was no report on recent export loadings of Canadian wheat. Prices of Class 2 wheat, all-milling grades, were down 1-7-8.
