**MONTREAL (CP)—The U.S.** dollar closed Thursday at a discount of 1 7/16 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, up 3/32. It took 98 9/16 cents Canadian to buy \$1 American. Pound sterling \$277 13/16, up 3/16.  
U. S. dollar, bid 98 17/32, asked 98 9/16.

## Lead And Zinc Markets Improve

**MONTREAL (CP)—Lead** and zinc markets have improved since the beginning of 1954, although the statistical position of zinc is still unfavorable, said R. E. Stavert, president of Consolidated Mining and Smelting at the company's annual meeting of shareholders on Thursday.  
Mr. Stavert said zinc exports to the United States have decreased but domestic production has shown only a slight drop. Interest was aroused following the U. S. announcement late in March that the administration would establish new long-term mineral stock-pile objectives.  
Production of fertilizers established a new record of 600,000 tons in 1953, but he said, there has been a temporary falling off in sales due to the accumulation of wheat from the last crop. However, he added, "the demand for all of our fertilizer products in our export markets remains strong and we are having no difficulty in disposing of our full output."

## Livestock
