New High for Imperial Oil

TORONTO, April 13—Total operating income of Imperial Oil Ltd. was greater in 1949 than in 1948, but earnings from manufacturing, marketing and marine sources dropped from 93-100 to 72-100 of one cent per gallon in spite of the fact that sales increased by eight per cent in volume, according to the company's annual report issued today.

Production Record

Imperial made and sold 1,962,000,000 gallons of products—a new high. The gross value of sales was \$364,739,023 and the net earnings from manufacturing and marketing were \$14,187,298.
