AGRICULTURE

AMELIORATION DES TROUPEAUX

L'amélioration des animaux de ferme est une question qui s'impose à l'attention du fermier, mais malheureusement plusieurs cultivateurs s'en préoccupent fort peu. Ils n'ont qu'un médiocre souci de produire de plus ou moins bons animaux. Ils oublient qu'une bête, ayant de multiples qualités, donne des produits meilleurs et qu'elle ne coûte pas plus à nourrir qu'une mauvaise. Ils ne sont pas assez particuliers pour le choix des reproducteurs. Et cependant l'amélioration du bétail est une des premières conditions d'une bonne culture. Les formes de l'animal sont, en premier lieu, à considérer, non pour le plaisir des yeux, mais parce que l'animal bien conformé donne un meilleur profit. Les qualités laitières doivent être recherchées en même temps que les qualités au viande; la véritable amélioration consiste, en effet, à ne jamais séparer ces deux précieuses qualités. C'est chose difficile à trouver, mais il y a maintes races qui réunissent à la fois ces deux privilèges, entre autres, la race cotentine et la Shorthorn laitière. L'utilité de l'amélioration du bétail dans ses formes, dans sa construction, dans ses qualités, en viande et en lait, ne peut être mise en doute.

Le premier moyen à employer pour parvenir à l'amélioration, c'est la sélection, c'est d'éliminer toujours les mauvais animaux et de ne conserver pour la reproduction, que les bêtes de choix.

La sélection a été, surtout, appliquée, avec une scrupuleuse attention et un esprit de suite remarquable, en Angleterre. Les éleveurs anglais se sont transmis les uns aux autres, de père en fils, les plus saines traditions en matière d'élevage et ont réussi à former des races qui se maintiennent avec une homogénéité parfaite. Les linoléums ne devraient jamais être frottés, mais lavés avec un linge et de l'eau tiède dans laquelle on aura mis un peu de sel.

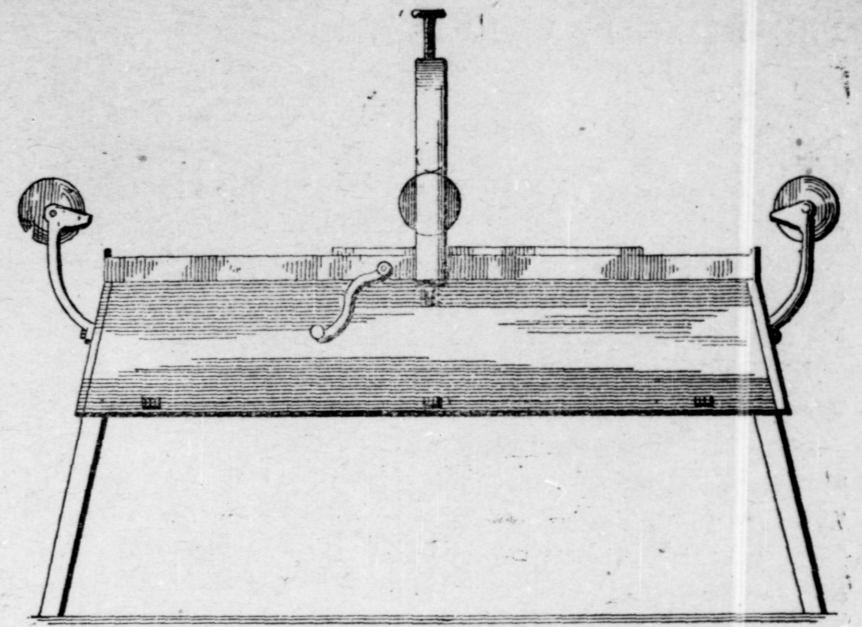
La poudre de borax nettoie bien les articles de cuisine émaillés.

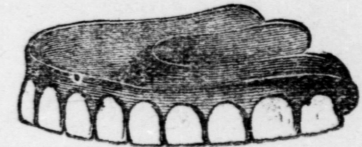
