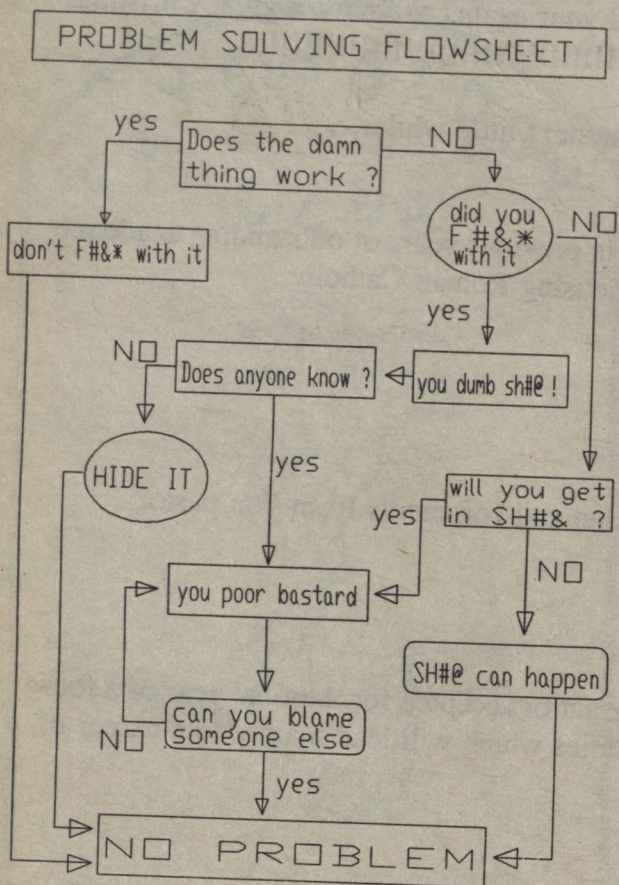
Engineering Quote of the Week --
