With thoughts of spring just around the corner an old timer here says farmers were plowing the fields in the spring of 1906 April 2 and in later years were working on the land Dec. 6.

The latest fishing season ever started here was 1921 when the season did not start until May 24, and the following year May 18. But an old fisherman here recalls away back near the turn of the century when the ice was piled solid on the shore on the night of June 9 as fishermen retired. In the morning they were surprised to find the ice all gone and the blue sea beckoning them. What happened to the ice during the night hours of that year long ago has never been known. Some say it sank, and providence moved it while the fishermen slept.

Every day stories are published of champions, and in days gone by Bristol also had many champions. First was the great John Lapierre, champion skater with the old stock skates. There was the great Robert Lapierre, champion egg eater, who downed 33 eggs on a wager he could down three dozen at one sitting. In the late Alfred McEwen's store Mr. Lapierre, downed the eggs one after the other but was refused the other three for fear he might suffer from it. But he said "I never felt so good." William MacDonald, who attended the feast is still around to tell the story.

Another champion here was the late George Gelderd, who bet he could eat six fresh herrings at a meal cooked as they came from the sea, heads and all. He did just that along with a pot of blue potatoes and suffered no ill effects.

Another champion here was the late Pius Walsh, a great single ploughman. He could hang his coat on a stake at the far end of a long field and strike out a furrow with his team and single plough without a kink or rough spot and in a straight line. He was known as the straightest ploughman of his time and his son Joe, who still resides on the old home farm likes to tell of his father's feats in ploughmanship.

James Conohan, who is still around and in retirement now, was well-known as a boxer and at a young age challenged any man on the Island to fight him with the bare knuckles to a finish. There was no takers but a Kensington man said he was interested but never came forth.

A farmer in Burns Road district whose farm was pestered with rats to no end thought up a type of poison made with Paris Green and flour. He put it out one night only and reported the next morning a path was trodden through his hay field deep into the clay done by the rats leaving away from the barn after one of their number had eaten the mixture. He was the champion rat exterminator.

Hughie McKay, was the champion one-man fiddler at dances and horse frolics. Hughie played his fiddle at a party one night continuously for 11 hours stopping only at intervals. He refused to let anyone take his place.

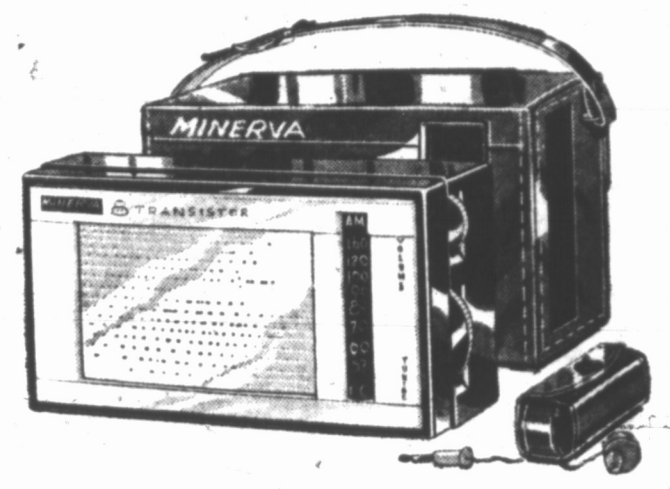

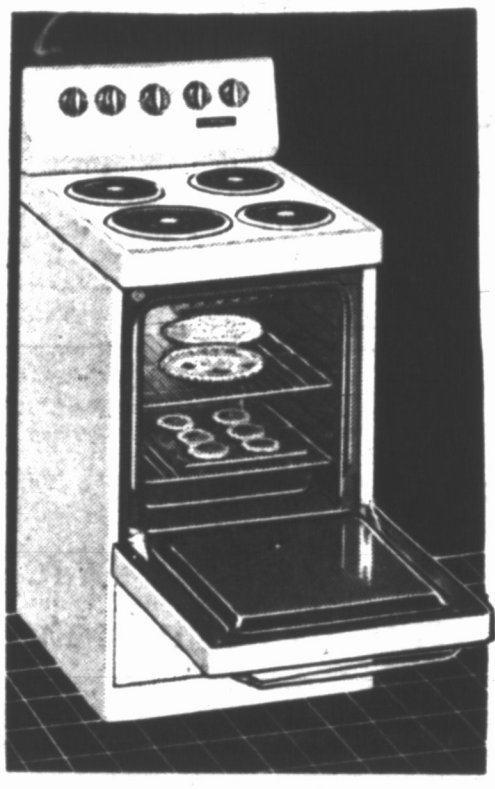

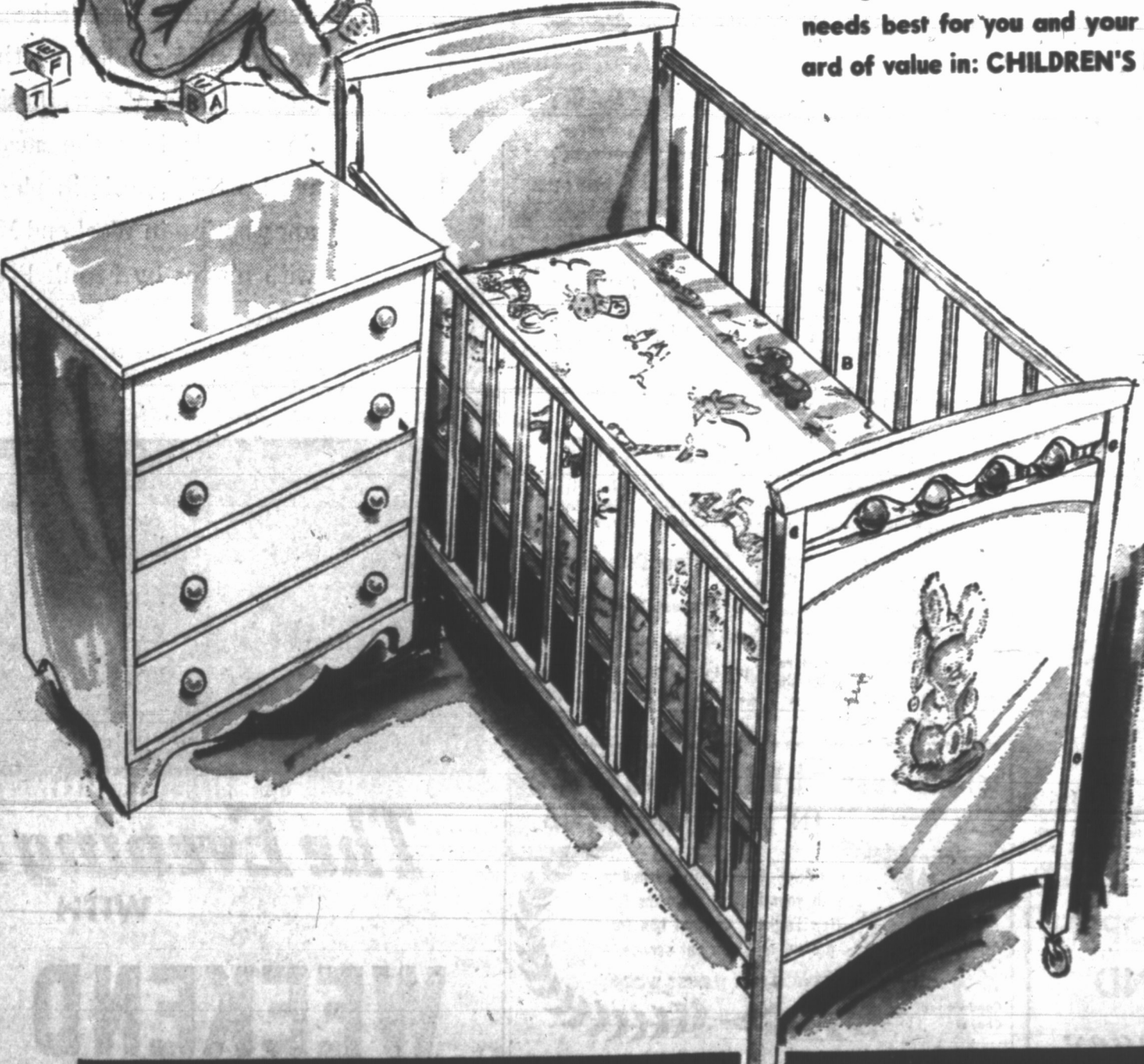
