

Data Given On Shady Car Deals

TORONTO (CP)—The Better Business Bureau opened its files on used car dealers here and revealed cases of trickery, exorbitant interest rates and refusals to fulfil guarantees.

A bulging file contained 122 complaints against five dealers alone, each operating under a variety of company names. The bureau said it has complaints against many more dealers.

It said, however, that many dealers operate honestly and many others settle complaints when advised of them by the bureau.

The bureau opened its files after Donald C. MacDonald, leader of the Ontario New Democratic Party, called for an investigation into shady car deals.

NDP CHARGE
The NDP leader listed in a statement 16 cases taken from the files of the Better Business Bureau, in which he alleged used car companies had collected a total of \$1,500 in deposits and then refused to refund the money when lack of financing stopped the deals from being completed.

The bureau said complaints of refusals to fulfil repair guarantees on used cars were more prevalent than the most common complaint was excessive interest shown:

1. Six-per-cent financing that turns out to be 12 per cent.
2. One case where the interest rate was 20 per cent a year.
3. Customers who signed "insurance" papers to try out cars, then found themselves committed to 30 monthly payments.
4. One customer who left his own car to take another on a seven-day trial basis and three days later found his car had been sold and was told he had bought the trial car.

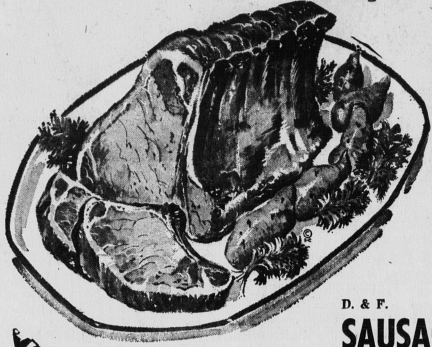

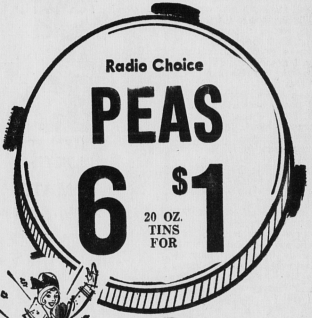
