Leadership awards

1. Students eligible for a Leadership Award must be full-time students who have satisfied the entrance requirements to the University or have passed at least eight three semester hour courses in the previous year of study. A student who has enrolled in fewer than eight courses in the previous year will normally be expected to complete all of the courses in which he/she was enrolled.
2. Awards will be given to students who have made, are making, or have demonstrated the potential for making a significant leadership contribution to University life.
3. An award may be given to a student participating in University athletic activities, but only if the student demonstrates significant leadership ability through his/her participation.
4. Nominations for awards may be made by students, faculty, or staff of the University.
5. Recipients for the awards will be chosen by a committee appointed by the president of the University.
