

Pearson, Peacock To Discuss Gov't Change

OTTAWA (CP) — Prime Minister Lester B. Pearson and Conservative leader Louis St. Laurent made the same move when Mr. Diefenbaker and the Conservatives won their first minority victory on June 10, 1957. They met— as will Mr. Diefenbaker and Mr. Pearson—two weeks after election day, and the government changed hands four days later on June 21.

When the armed forces vote was announced, turning two seats over to the Liberals which had been in the Conservative camp on the basis of last Monday's civilian voting, Mr. Diefenbaker tried to phone Mr. Pearson.

Mr. Pearson's line was busy, and Mr. Diefenbaker sent the Liberal leader the following telegram: "As soon as the service vote was announced, I immediately (Continued on page 2, col. 3)
