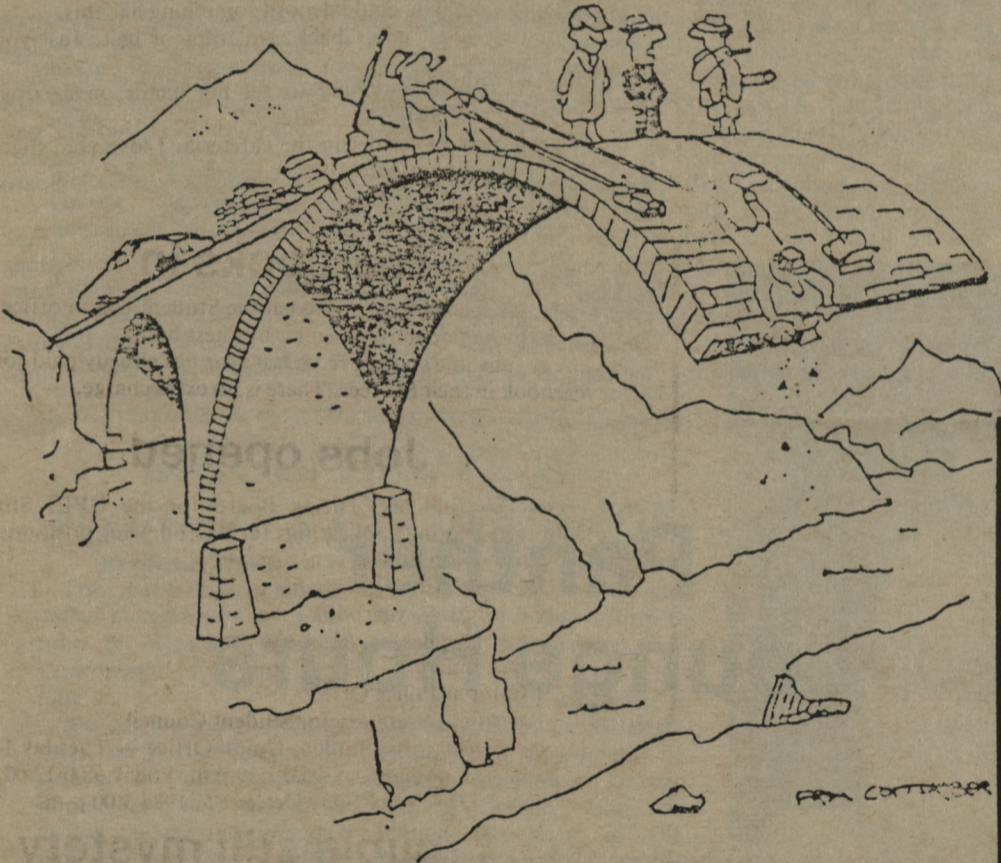
1. What language is spoken by French Canadians?
