

Timetable Arranged For ECM Discussion

BRUSSELS (Reuters) — Britain and the European Common Market countries agreed Monday on a full timetable for further ministerial talks on Britain's bid to join the six-nation trade bloc.

Informed sources here said agreement was reached after Britain's chief negotiator, Deputy Foreign Secretary Edward Heath, urged ministers from the six to hold more meetings with him in an attempt to speed up negotiations.

The sources said the ministers agreed to meet Oct. 25 and 27 to discuss Britain's agriculture, exports from India, Pakistan and Ceylon to an enlarged Common Market, and Britain's request for no tariffs on a number of essential raw materials.

The sources said Britain and the six — France, West Germany, Italy, Belgium, Holland and Luxembourg — also will meet at ministerial level on Oct. 16 and 17 to discuss temporary trade agreements.

Heath also agreed with the other ministers on a meeting to set up negotiations. The sources said Heath stressed that they should be arranged, the sources said.

WASHINGTON (AP)—President's special adviser Chester Bowles has proposed a carrot-and-stick approach to nations seeking U.S. foreign aid. In a memorandum being circulated among top Kennedy administration figures, the former undersecretary of state suggested that some countries, such as Greece, Venezuela, Argentina and Chile, be cut off from direct foreign aid until they make important internal reforms.

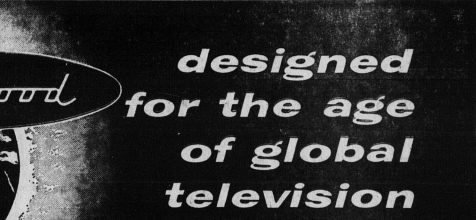
