Need For Medical Care Plan Doubled By Alberta Doctor

EDMONTON (AP) — A universal prepaid medical care plan is not "as necessary as it is made out to be," Health Minister J. Donovan Ross of Alberta told the royal commission on health services.

Dr. Ross disagreed with a suggestion by Commissioner O. J. Firestone that there is an "overwhelming demand" for a comprehensive, government-supported medical plan.

"There are other things we should look at before going into an area where needs are already being met," he said. He admitted, however, that if the federal government offered to pay half the cost of a universal program Alberta would have "two other choices" but to consider instituting one.

Dr. Ross was the chief witness as the Social Credit government presented its brief to the commission, which opened five-day public hearings.

OPPOSES PLANS

The question of a government-supported medical plan was touched upon only obliquely in the brief itself—"the government of Alberta has consistently opposed so-called socialized health and medical services, believing that such programs are incompatible with the rights and re-

sponsibilities inherent in a free and democratic society." It was amply covered, however, in a prolonged question-and-answer session.

A subject dealt with in detail in the brief — and in oral examination — was that of drug costs, which the Alberta government said are too high at the retail level.

Alberta called for establishment of a federal agency with power to examine the cost-revenue position of individual drugs and take action to reduce prices.

Chief Justice Emmett Hall of Saskatchewan, chairman of the commission, said the question of drug costs is receiving "careful and continued attention" from the commission. But he raised the question of whether parliament has "the legislative competence to regulate drug prices."

Mr. Frawley said the drug trade is interprovincial commerce and comes under federal jurisdiction. He suggested the federal food and drug directorate might be given added powers to cope with drug prices.
