

Canadian Toy Industry Puts Product On Show

MONTREAL (CP)—An Indian doll named after what is recorded as the origin of Canada's name and a sled with controls worthy of an outboard motorboat are among new toys on view at the Canadian Toy Fair, organized by the 14-member Canadian Playthings Manufacturers Incorporated, gives store buyers from Canada and as well as a week to see just about every toy being produced in Canada.

The fair, which opened Monday, also gives the curious a preview of toys which will be featured in stores during the coming winter, fall and Christmas seasons.

The black-haired Indian doll is called "Princess Kanata" and was modelled after real life Indian Princess Kahn, Tina Horn of the Mohawk tribe.

"Kanata" was said to be the first Indian word heard by explorer Jacques Cartier when Inuit guides led him up the St. Lawrence River to a point they called "Kanata," which was the Indian term for village and believed to be the origin of the country's name.

The inspiration for "Princess Kanata" is a 25-year-old model for a fur company who designed the clothes for the doll which will be made at the Caughnawaga reserve near Montreal.

There will be three traditional Indian costumes for the doll representing different Iroquois groups from across Canada as well as five modern outfits.

Makers of the doll plan to introduce the toy on an international level by showing it at the New York International Toy Fair starting March 8.

The new sled has a front like a toboggan, steering wheel, a rudder to control speed and steering and braking like a boat. Its frame and seat are wood and the bottom is aluminum.

The toy fair continues the trend towards realistic dolls with fashionable clothes and models that talk and cry. One doll can be burped after she takes her bottle.

The play toy field features a new series of Canadian wildlife including Canada, grizzly and polar bears, beaver, walrus, buffalo, skunk, hare and bighorn sheep.

The toy industry in Canada is expecting sales of more than \$150,000,000 at the retail level this year, include exports of \$1,000,000, most of them to Australia.

And which finances \$75 million to all at age 70. These are financed by special tax revenues earmarked for the purpose.

Pension payments in the expiring fiscal year have been estimated at \$807,000,000—a jump from the original forecast of \$75,000,000 because of the \$10 increase in the pension which took effect last Oct. 1.

CITIES DEFERENT BASE
In a C.O.M. no. 11 statement made as it tabled the estimates, Mr. Gordon cautioned that it would be misleading to compare the new Blue Book spending estimates with the current year's book.

For one thing, this showed a boost of \$162,800,000 in the cost of carrying the public debt—a total of \$1,077,260,000. Mr. Gordon said the increase would actually be about \$52,000,000 because of a "serious underestimate" in the 1963-64 figure.

Mr. Gordon said that a "substantial cut-backs" in many spending programs.

But he added that new programs and new government functions added to his spending plans.

Several substantial "extras" inevitably will be added to next year's program in the form of supplementary estimates.

PROVINCES GET MORE

One is an \$87,000,000 increase in payments to provincial governments under the improvement in the federal-provincial tax arrangement announced last November but not yet legislated by Parliament.

No provision has been made for special railway freight rate subsidies, which took \$70,000,000 in the current year or for municipal winter works incentive payments or subsidies for winter housebuilding, which together took \$55,000,000 this fiscal year. Future government policy in both these fields has not yet been determined, but major payments are virtually certain.

Besides its budgetary outlays and pension payments, the government will have to find funds for a variety of loans, investments and advances which are not counted as budgetary costs since they add to government assets. As a starter, Mr. Gordon listed \$108,877,000 of these compared with \$228,197,644 loaned so far this year.

Power Distributor In Nfld. Is Opposed to Cycle Split

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP)—The manager of one of Newfoundland's major power distributors says the United States Force base at Stephenville is an expensive burden for the province. He says the province "won't touch" Newfoundland power if the government goes ahead with a cycle split of the entire western sector of the province to 50 cycle frequency.

The Newfoundland Power Commission announced earlier that an imaginary line would be drawn from Bay d'Espérance south to the Burlington Peninsula in the north. All power consumed on the western side would be 50 cycle and all power on the eastern side would be 60 cycle.

They said completion of the changeover of all communities would take up to 10 years.

J. C. Ryan, managing director of United Towns Electric Company said Monday his company was "very unhappy" with the government's plan to divide the province electrically and advocated converting all areas to the standard 60 cycle power.

"By doing so, the power commission may provide itself with a market for about 8,000 horsepower—the amount which is required to operate the American base at Stephenville."

U.S. Imports Of Oil Down

WASHINGTON (AP)—U.S. oil imports totalled 1,916,276 barrels daily during the last six months of 1963, down from the average of 2,063,600 barrels daily during the first half of the year, the interior department reported here.

The totals for the last half of 1963 included 1,628,728 barrels daily imported under a license when the mandatory oil import control program, and 258,173 barrels daily from Canada and 29,382 barrels daily from Mexico under exemption from the mandatory program at overland land imports.

The comparable figures for the first half of 1963 were 1,760,100 barrels daily under licence and 293,300 barrels daily from Canada and 30,000 barrels daily from Mexico under exemptions.
