WORKER-MANAGER-
CAPITALIST
The Canadian Labour Congress
publishes each month a bulletin
in "Labour Research". The re-
cent edition makes some inter-
esting comparisons between the
situation of farmers and labour.
One section we quote, "The
farmer looking at these com-
parisons, will not fail to point
out that his situation is really
even worse than that of the
worker is only a worker, an
employee, doing what he's told.
The farmer is a worker plus
he is a worker, working hard,
with his own hands and brain-
power, but he is not being
paid as a capitalist. He has
the responsibility of manage-
ment as well as the work of
labour. He has a considerable
investment, not only of his
time and energy (like the work-
er), but of money too. Even if
he were getting as much as the
industrial worker, which he
plainly is not, he would not
be getting enough; he ought to
get the wages a worker gets for
a week's work in the industry
plus something for his work as
manager, plus a reasonable re-
turn on his investment."
How much the farmer is en-
titled to as manager, no one can
say. He ought to get it. He
ought to get it as a fair
return on his investment, no one
can even make a reasonable
guess at the 1961 Census fi-
gures are available.

ECONOMIC PLANNING
On Tuesday, Dec. 11, more
than 200 people with agricul-
tural interest met at Truro to con-
sider matters related to volun-
tary economic planning in the
province. The forenoon of the
gathering was devoted to talk-
ing in the premises of the pro-
vince, minister of agriculture,
Dr. Waldo Walsh. Hon. G. I.
Smith, the Hon. Mr. Man-
son, in the afternoon five dif-
ferent groups - dairy, livestock,
horticulture, poultry and

might be termed a master plan
for agriculture in Nova Scotia.
ARDA PROJECTS

Queries Made
On New Drug
OTTAWA (CP) - The federal
health department has asked
other countries whether they
have any evidence connecting
the drug trifluoperazine with
birth deformities, a spokesman
said.
The action was taken as a
precaution after a physician
wrote to a regional medical
journal in England reporting
that a woman who had taken
the drug during pregnancy gave
birth to twins with shortened
limbs.
The spokesman said the drug
is an ingredient of several pre-
parations sold under prescription
in Canada.
In a letter to physicians last
month, Health Minister Mon-
teith mentioned trifluoperazine
as among drugs which should
be prescribed with caution.
He referred to the drug in
announcing that preparations
containing melazine - an in-
gredient in a drug suspected by
Swedish authorities of being
connected with congenital mal-
formations - were being brought
under prescription control.
