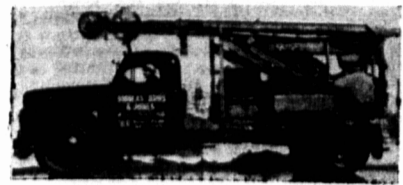

Queens Co. Plowing Match Provides For 4-H Class

Special feature of this year's Queen's County Plowing Match and Tractor Rodeo, will be the introduction of a new plowing class for juniors. This class is restricted to youths who are members of one of the provincial 4-H Clubs. In addition to an award for the highest individual point winners, there will be awarded also a prize to the 4-H Club team standing first in the competition. As a result match officials hope to spark further interest in the contests among the younger age groups.

This year's plowing competitions will be held September 2nd on the farm of Hazen Howard, Cornwall. As last year the competitions are open to anyone in the province. It is expected that two of Nova Scotia's outstanding plowmen will be in attendance.

DEFENDING CHAMPION

Also on hand at the Cornwall competition will be Stanley Willis, the defending champion. Mr. Willis has been invited to compete in the World Plowing Championships which this year are to take place at Peebles, Ohio, in September.

It is expected that the Queen's County Plowing Match and Tractor Rodeo will be opened officially by Hon. A.W. Matheson, Premier of the province. Others scheduled to speak at the opening ceremonies are R.R. Bell, Q.C., George Kitson, and Heath MacQuarrie, M.P.

Chief judge this year will be Mr. D. M. Gilchrist, a member of the N.B. Department of Agriculture staff stationed at Fredericton. He will be assisted by Dave Peacock of the P.E.I. Ag-

ricultural Department. David McLean, also of the P.E.I. Department of Agriculture, will handle the Tractor Rodeo.

OTHER EVENTS

The junior sports meet will be in charge of Donnie Smith, while Arnold Bruce and H.P. Smith will take care of the Highland Dancing program, which this year is restricted to novice dancers, twelve years and under. A pipe band sponsored by the International Fertilizer Company will be headed by Pipe Major MacLeod of Charlottetown.

The catering will be done by the members of the Ladies Aid of the Cornwall United Church together with the Cornwall Women's Institute.

Among the many prizes up for competition during this major agricultural event are: a prize for the youngest boy and youngest girl entered in the competitions, donated by R.R. Bell Q.C.; a prize for the 4-H Club Team amassing the greatest number of

points, donated by E.D. Reid; and a prize for the boy 16 years of age or under showing the most improvement from last year. This last-named prize is donated by Mr. Elliot Robertson, President of the Match Committee.

SENTENCED TO DEATH

NICOSIA (AP) — A Nicosia special court Friday sentenced two young Greek Cypriots to death for carrying arms and ammunition last July. Costas Michael, 25, and Demetriakis Christou, 19, admitted belonging to EOK, the underground demanding union with Greece. They said they had not killed anyone or even fired a shot.
