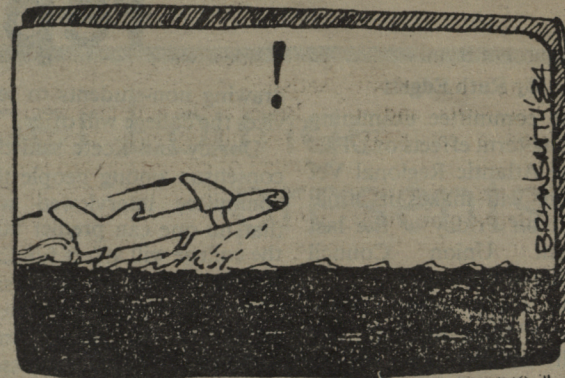


Monday, April 16: Exams begin their inexorable cycle once again. Prepare to die.

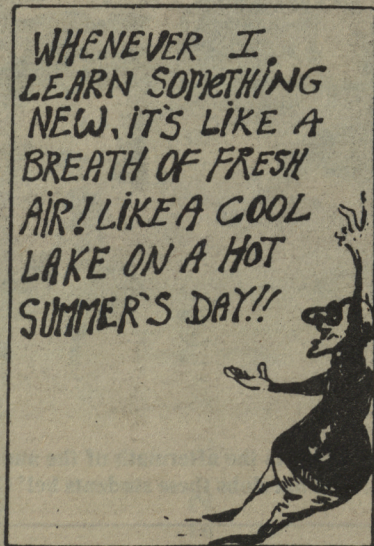
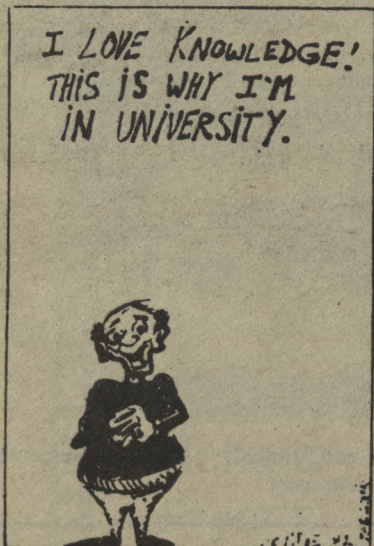
