

### Probe Planned On Color TV

OTTAWA (CP) — The Board of Broadcast Governors has announced that it will hold another public hearing on color television this fall with a view to determining when color TV can be introduced into Canada.

The board said in a statement it will receive briefs and representations on color TV at its public hearing opening here Nov. 3.

Following a public hearing here in January, 1963, the BBG announced that the time had not yet arrived when it could recommend a start on color TV in Canada.

Since then, the board says it has maintained its study of the color TV situation in the United States and has held discussions with Canadian broadcasters concerning a possible target date for introduction of color TV here.

### Editorial Writer Killed In Crash

MONTREAL (CP) — Alfred Ayoite, 39, an editorial writer for Montreal La Presse who wrote in Saturday's edition on the danger of Victoria Day weekend traffic accidents, was killed Monday in a head-on collision.

Mr. Ayoite's car and one driven by Ovide Pazzis collided on Taschereau Boulevard in suburban Jacques-Cartier.

Mr. Pazzis is in critical condition in the general hospital at St. Lambert, a suburb of the St. Lawrence River's south shore where Mr. Ayoite lived.

### Expert Claims Beatles Can Produce Trance

MONTREAL (CP) — A British expert on brainwashing says his country's Beatles can produce trance states in some youngsters similar to those induced by voodoo or witch doctors.

Dr. William Sargant, chief of psychological medicine at St. Thomas's Hospital, London, made the comment while reviewing his studies of certain common methods of conversion used from classical Greek times to the present.

He told a staff conference of the Allan Memorial Institute and the Montreal General Hospital Tuesday the same trance-like state can be observed among fans of the Beatles as on the faces of girls portrayed in Greek vases fashioned in 600 B.C.

"The human nervous system has not changed in half a million years," Dr. Sargant said, explaining that feelings of fear and anger are essential for conversion and brainwashing and can be accentuated by rhythmic preparations with drums and dancing.

African "psychiatrists" kept subjects overbreathing while dancing. Eventually, some fell into a trance making it easy to convert them to a new point of view of emotional problems.

Dr. Sargant said he used much the same methods in the Second World War while treating soldiers broken down by battle neurosis.

Dr. Sargant told the research psychiatrist in his audience Hitler had prepared his people for war with similar methods and 90,000 were killed.

"Everybody can be affected," he said. "We are all vulnerable."

### Building Cleared By Bomb Report

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP) — Confederation Building, Newfoundland's legislative and central office building, was evacuated Wednesday afternoon after a warning that a bomb had been placed in it.

An anonymous telephone caller warned a switchboard operator that a bomb had been placed and would go off at any time. It was reported.

The building was immediately cleared and the RCMP were reported searching for the bomb. Confederation Building is on the outskirts of the city on a high rise of land overlooking both the city and St. John's harbor.

The province's legislative chambers are located on the ninth and 10th floors. A museum houses the 11th floor. Lower levels contain government offices, including that of Premier Smallwood on the eighth floor.

### Moncton Group Signs For Fair

NEW YORK (CP) — The Gentones, a Moncton, N.B. rock 'n' roll group, will appear at the Louisiana pavilion of the New York world's fair from Aug. 2 to 15, a spokesman for the teen carnival said Wednesday.

The teen carnival is staged nightly at the Louisiana pavilion in the fair's federal and states section and provides opportunity for teen-agers to dance and watch a stage performance.

**ATTEMPT FOILED**  
OSLO (Reuters) — An attempt to blow up the royal estate where Russian Premier Nikita Khrushchev will stay during his official visit to Norway at the end of next month, was foiled early Tuesday, police said. About four pounds of powerful explosives ready to be detonated were found seven yards from a corner of the building.
