Montague Primroses ended the Island Senior Hockey League schedule at the Sports Arena last night by trimming the league-leading Parkdale Flyers 14-9 in a wide-open, free-scoring tussle before only a small crowd of fans.

There wasn't much depending on the outcome of the game and both teams fattened up their scoring averages, especially Orin Carver who is chasing Merrill Pineau of the B.Y.C. for goal-scoring honors.

Carver triggered five goals to boost his season's goal output to a gaudy 48 in 21 games. He also added an assist to give himself a league-leading total of 81 points.

Ronnie Ketch played a great game for the Primroses. He alternated with Harley MacLean in centering Dowling and Flick Landry. The Primroses may prove a lot tougher in the playoffs than is generally thought.

Swede Winner Of Ski Ch'ship ADERMAAT, Switzerland (AP) — John Ivarsson, a Swedish infantry lieutenant, won the individual event of the Swiss international military ski championships Thursday. Ivarsson beat more than 50 army skiers from 12 nations in the gruelling 15.5 kilometre (about nine miles) competition which included two slalom and one cross-country race. He finished in the combined time of two hours, nine minutes, 32.3 seconds. Sgt. Walter Loetscher of Switzerland was second in 2:12:20.8. Pte. G. R. Lacasse of Quebec City was the leading Canadian. He wound up in 42nd place.

Larsen Satisfied With New Pact ST. PETERSBURG, Fla. (AP) — Don Larsen, the unpredictable right-hander who pitched a perfect game against Brooklyn in last year's world series, Thursday signed his 1957 contract with the New York Yankees only a few hours before he would have become an official holdout. Estimates put Larsen's salary at \$18,000, a \$6,000 increase over his 1956 pact. "I'm very satisfied and ready to go to work," said Larsen after reaching agreement with Lee Macphail, assistant to general manager George Weiss. The world champions thus completed their contract negotiations for the coming season. Players unsigned by midnight Thursday night officially are listed as holdouts.

Bob Schmidt To Get Tryout At Sarni's Spot PHOENIX, Ariz. (AP) — A 23-year-old catcher who never has played higher than AA professional baseball was suddenly thrust in the New York Giants spotlight Thursday following disclosure that heart attack had cut short Bill Sarni's playing career. The young man is Bob Schmidt, who very likely was ticketed for the minors, but now will be given an opportunity to win the Giants No. 1 catching position. "He's going to get a good shot at the first string job," said Manager Bill Rigney. "Maybe he can come all the way in a hurry. I know the jump from Dallas is a big one, but it's been done before and Bob has the tools." By the "tools" Rigney meant fine defensive quality, including a powerful arm, and a 300-pound frame. Schmidt batted .363 for Dallas in the Texas League last season and hit 13 home runs while driving in 66 runs in 111 games.
