LONDON, April 29.—Regulations governing the admission of visitors to the galleries of the House of Commons have been made more strict in consequence of anonymous threats being made to blow up the house with dynamite. A special guard of detectives follow Secretary Matthews around, fearing an anarchist's rage.

Preparing for May Day.

PARIS, April 29.—The authorities are taking extensive precautions to repress disorders on May Day. Extra troops are ready to start for the city. Public buildings and monuments will be guarded. Managers of the English and American shops near the Grand Opera house have received threatening letters stating that all houses not French will be blown up.

Montreal News.

MONTREAL, April 29.—Goslin, the assistant city clerk, has sent a letter to his wife saying he will never return to Montreal. His disappearance still causes great sensation.

The Board of Trade will oppose the increased duty on carpets, as proposed by the Dominion Government.

Revolutionist Leader Captured.

NEW YORK, April 29.—A Lagbayana, Venezuela, despatch says the Government troops captured the son of General Crespo, revolutionist leader. He will be executed the day his father comes in league with Baracaso.

Parson Downs Victorious.

BOSTON, April 29.—In the case of the Rev. Mr. Downs, for malicious prosecution against three members of the Bowdoin Square Baptist Church, the jury returned a verdict giving plaintiff \$10,000 damages.

Militia Report.

The report of the inspecting officers for the Island militia is as follows:—
Lt.-Col. Mortizambert says of the Garrison Artillery in Charlottetown, commanded by Captains J. A. Longworth and H. M. Davison: "Both batteries very well turned out; gun drill without a fault."

Major Mayne, R. E., reports of the Charlottetown Engineers, commanded by Capt. W. A. Weeks: "I inspected them on the 14th November, 1891. The turnout and infantry drill of this company was good, and the company books had been well kept. The state of the company reflects great credit on its officers. It is fairly well provided with engineering equipments and small stores. The company has splendid opportunities for bridging work if it only had the material for the purpose. Owing to the lateness of the season, I could only inspect such engineering work as could be done in the drill hall. This work was well and intelligently done, the officers themselves superintending the details."

Major Gordon reports of No. 3 Co., 82nd Battalion, commanded by Captain D. Stewart: "This company looked very smart and soldier-like on parade, arms, clothing and accoutrements clean. Company drill and manual firing exercises performed in a very satisfactory manner."

Mr. Norton and the Medical Act.

To the Editor of The Guardian.

Sir,—Mr. E. H. Norton's reply to my letter in re the Medical Act is prima facie evidence that he does not understand the matter. Bacon says: "Men's thoughts are much according to their inclinations; then discourses and speeches according to their learning and infused opinions."

As the Medical Act has become law, it is not necessary to prolong a discussion as to its merits; neither do I deem it necessary to resort to the imagination and picture his legal and mercantile mistakes without adding facts. PANIC AT A THEATRE FIRE.

Fifty Persons Crushed and Maimed in a Philadelphia Play House.

SIX ARE REPORTED MISSING.

PHILADELPHIA, April 28.—Fire broke out shortly before 8 o'clock, p. m., tonight on the stage of the Grand Central theatre and before it was subdued nearly a million dollars worth of property had been destroyed, including the massive eight-story annex building occupied by the Times newspaper. The panic in the theatre was great. Nearly fifty persons, mostly occupants of the galleries, were hurt, none, however, seriously. The Grand Central theatre is located on Walnut street, between Eighth and Ninth, in the most thickly populated portion of the city. Immediately in the rear of the theatre was the Times building, which faced Sanson street. At the theatre "The Devil's Auction" was being presented. The house fortunately was only partly filled.

Frightful Panic in the Theatre.

The panic that ensued, however, was terrible. As the confusion subsided the casualties were found to be more serious than was at first supposed. Forty-one people were admitted to the Pennsylvania hospital. Most of them were suffering from burns and about twenty are in a serious condition. The injuries are mainly about the face, and many, it is feared, have been blinded by the fierce flames they fought their way through. The Jefferson hospital attended to thirty of the injured, but of this number only nine were seriously enough burned to be kept in it.

It is reported that William L. Brooks, Vincennes Chilton, Sarah Goldman, Thomas Lorella and his wife, Flora, and a Miss Conyers, all of the theatrical company playing at the Walnut street theatre are missing.
