Rockabye Ross Wins Decision

NORTH SYDNEY, N. S., Oct. 14 (CP)—George (Rockabye) Ross, Cape Breton's most popular fighter, won a unanimous decision over Eddie Zastre of Winnipeg, Canadian light heavyweight champion.

Although he gave away nine pounds to the rangy westerner, Ross was in front almost all the way in the bristling battle. It was never in doubt once the West Bay Road

fighter, looking sharper than he has in years, solved Zastre's style. Ross weighed 161, Zastre 170.

The victory put Ross in line for a fight with middleweight champion Roy Wouters of Montreal and Vancouver, who dethroned him two years ago, or Yvon Durelle of Chatham, N.B., who is recognized in some places as logical contender for Wouters title, although he and Ross have never met.
