king of clubs with the ace and draw two rounds of trumps, you would have second thoughts about the matter. You realize that the heart finesse will probably fail because it is unlikely that East would open the bidding with a preemptive bid of three diamonds, holding six diamonds with 100 hearts, the king of clubs, and the queen of hearts as well.

Once you come to the conclusion that the heart finesse is more likely to fail than not, you naturally start to look for other ways of playing the hand which would give you a better chance. And no sooner do you do this than you realize that the hand can be made even if West has the queen of hearts.

Having made your decision to play West for the queen, you cash the queen of clubs, the ace of diamonds, and the A-K of hearts.

Then you lead the jack of hearts. When West covers with the queen, you discard a diamond from dummy after first congratulating yourself on having guessed the heart situation correctly.

West is now in the unhappy position where he must retreat either a heart or a club. This permits you to discard dummy's last diamond and you will, in your hand, and the end result is that you make six spades after all.

2 Persons Are Charged For Royal Visit Actions

QUEBEC (CP) — Two of 27 persons charged in connection with the royal visit here last weekend pleaded guilty Tuesday and were fined \$10 and costs each. A bench warrant was issued for Jacques Cloutier, 39, of Nicolet, Que., who did not appear when his name was called. The other 26, including three women, pleaded not guilty. Most of the charges dealt with some form of disturbing the peace, such as by yelling and waving flags.

Price Stability Stressed As Important To Canada

By Ken Smith Canadian Press Business Editor TORONTO (CP)—Any careful study of Canada's economic strength and potential must include confidence in the United States banker says. Kennedy M. Spang, vice-president of the overseas division of New York's First National City Bank, told the Canadian Export Association Canada cannot afford to be either domestic or foreign investment and "will remain at it as long as the eye can peer into the future."

"Canada's diversified resource base is being skillfully developed to supply the needs of a sizeable proportion of the industrial raw materials and semi-processed goods required for further economic growth. The nation's high rate of investment in plant and equipment is creating a modern, efficient and diversified industrial foundation. The Canadian market large enough to sustain mass production techniques has improved Canada's competitive position vis-a-vis its industrial trading partners."

Mr. Spang—who has had a special interest in Canada through its control of Mercantile Bank of Canada—emphasized the need, however, for Canadian businessmen to fight for a bigger share of foreign markets.

And, he said, maintaining stability of costs and prices is the key to this drive—a vital step in helping solve the country's worrisome balance of payments problems.

The scope for reducing foreign debt incurred through interest and dividend payments is limited and the capital requirements of both industry and public corporation can be met only with the help of further foreign borrowing, he said.

This would add to the already-large servicing of the foreign debt and so Canada must expand both its traditional exports and sales of its new and increasingly competitive manufactures in order to approach a balance on current accounts.

"It must develop export markets to get benefits of volume level of production capable of assuring competitive prices for its goods both in Canada and abroad."

"More and more manufacturing industries are becoming exporting industries. There is a need for marketing tools to develop markets for the United States and especially in other growing and less-familiar markets of the world."

Mr. Spang told the association overseas trade commissioners it cannot rely on Canada's overseas trade commissioners to find foreign outlets for Canadian goods. The job belongs to the business community itself.

Roads Program To Be Dropped

OTTAWA (CP)—The federal government is not considering renewal of the roads to roads program in its present form. Resources Minister Laing informed the Commons today.
