

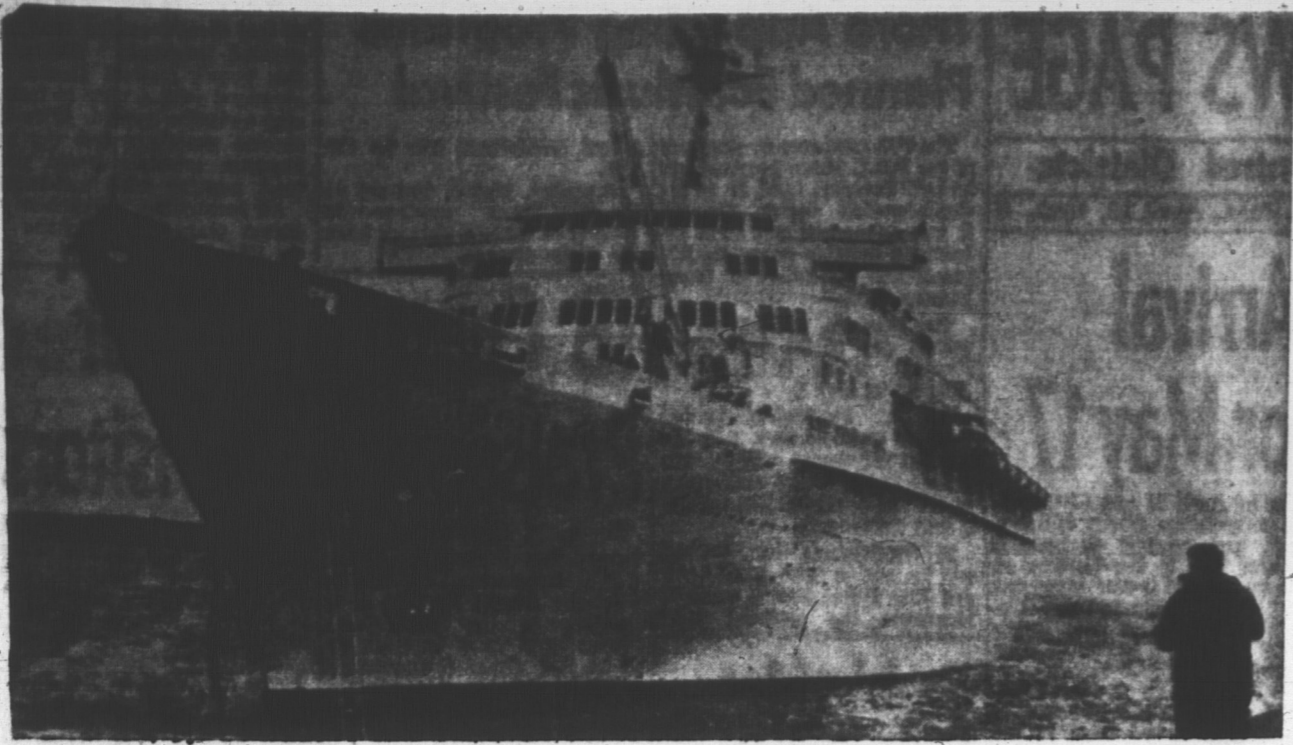
Rare Old Negatives Found Of Wright Brothers Plane

DAYTON, Ohio (AP) — Crane Carter, of Battle Creek, Mich., operator Wesley Carter looked into the pile of rotting, yellowed newspapers, then shouted to his fellow wreckers to stop work. He had found negatives of some rare pictures of the Wright Brothers, the Dayton bicycle mechanics who pioneered in aviation.

"It was a picture of one of the first airplanes built by the Wright Brothers." Carter and his co-workers then took the ceiling apart piece by piece, seeking other relics. But all they found was a 1918 dime.

NEWS TO NIECE
Mrs. Ivonette Wright Miller, a niece of the brothers who has all of Orville Wright's pictures and diaries, recognized the photo subjects, but said she had never seen these pictures before. They were taken, she said, in 1910 when Orville and Wilbur Wright set up a training camp

for flyers near Montgomery, Ala., for a time. There were more than 100 negatives, but most were blank or too deteriorated to print. One printable negative showed Orville Wright with two of his first flying students. Another showed four early pupils of the Wrights. Others showed a 1907 model Wright Brothers plane in flight.



NEW LINER ARRIVES AT HALIFAX

The Oceanic, new flagship of the Home Lines Fleet, is nudged toward a Halifax pier Monday at the end of her maiden Atlantic crossing from Italy. The 34,000-ton ship, built at a cost of \$35,000,000, sailed for New York after her first call at Halifax. Capt. Giovanni Ruffini was presented with a

plaque by Halifax port officials. The ship has an Italian crew of 600 and passenger capacity of 1,700. She is scheduled to go into cruise service to Nassau and in winter will make longer Caribbean tours. On cruise she will carry only 1,200 passengers. (CP Wirephoto)

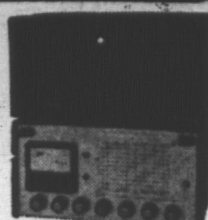
