Weather and Crops

Adequate rainfall is a necessity in the production of profitable crops. Usually we get sufficient but, not always when it is most needed. A year ago almost complete lack of rainfall during the germinating season hampered the crop.

The past week's weather, while distinctly beneficial to pasture and hay crops is holding up seeding. It is rarely, however, that climatic conditions ever completely prevent the harvesting of reasonably good crops in this province. There has been a great deal of talk about the weather but so far no one has done much about it.

At the present time the International Federation of Agricultural Producers are meeting in annual sessions at Mexico City. Agricultural representatives of twenty six nations will consider problems of world food production and distribution.

This Organization has been functioning for six years and the harmony achieved in its discussions is in striking contrast to the conflict and confusion which characterize many other international meetings.

Is The Farmer The Culprit?

Uncontrolled inflation has pushed the cost of many items of food to the point where the housewife is having difficulty in her continuous struggle to balance the budget. It is likely that many consumers faced with high food prices have come to the conclusion that farm returns have become highly speculative.

The chief cause of inflation, that agricultural producers have deliberately pushed their prices up and accordingly are largely to blame for the alleged high cost of living.

The farmer on the other hand is in a good position to prove that he receives the lowest rate per hour for his labor. Interest on his investment in plant and equipment at much less than 1-2 obtained in industry generally and no additional remuneration for management.

This latter fact is in strange contrast to the relatively high salaries paid for management in business and industry. What the urban consumers should not lose sight of is the fact that the complexity of modern living with millions of people crowded into urban centres has tremendously increased food distribution costs, costs which in no sense are chargeable to the farmer.

Potato Acreage

It is apparent that potato growers both in the United States and Canada are taking steps to reduce acreage this year. The recommendations of the P. E. I. Potato Marketing Board that the average should be reduced to 30 per cent appears both sensible and reasonable.

Anyone who makes predictions concerning future potato prices stands a very good chance of losing his reputation as a prophet. However, there does not appear to be any risk in stating that if production is continued at last year's level, prices will be low.

It is altogether likely that the acreage will be reduced by 30 per cent. That appears to be a logical step. But, there is apparently a substantial number of farmers who are planting no potatoes at all, a drastic procedure for the farmer who has in the past balanced up his system of crop production with a reasonable acreage of potatoes.

Whether it is better for the farmer to be sorry for growing potatoes rather than be sorry for not growing them, we leave to his own decision.

Early Hay

Present development of grass and clover varieties that having will be early this year and that in order to obtain the value from the hay crop, plans should be made to commence haying at as early a date as possible.

The purchase of high priced protein feeds cuts seriously into livestock profits. At the same time Island farmers undoubtedly lose tremendous quantities of valuable protein by allowing hay to reach maturity before cutting.

The making of hay is one of the most complicated operations on the farm and no hard and fast rule can be laid down for success.
