## Harvesting Season Was Perfect, Says Farmer

Grain can be dried at an average cost of two to three cents per bushel, but that's the purchase price of the equipment in something else.

This was the information given to a meeting in Kensington Regional High School Tuesday afternoon by representatives of several firms which sell drying equipment. Graeme Linkletter, agricultural engineer, P.E.I. department of agriculture, presided.

**FEW FARMERS**

Strangely enough very few farmers attended, though two men came all the way from Nova Scotia to learn the costs and the advantages of grain drying. There were 40 people in the meeting at the peak, there were 30 at the close, and most of them, apparently, were non farmers.

**RIGHT ANSWER**

Harry Pridham, Montrose had the right answer when he said, the harvesting season this year was perfect. "Had we had a wet harvest, and a lot of damp grain, this room wouldn't be big enough to hold the half of the farmers who would be here," Mr. Pridham observed.

There was fairly general agreement that this is a poor year to sell grain-drying equipment, though a few of the island's better farmers were present.

Rough costs for a large unit capable of handling 15,000 bushels of grain were given as \$6,500—that figure includes a cost of \$2,200 for a grain bin. The outfit would dry 250 bushels of grain per hour, a spokesman said.

Costs for a smaller unit were estimated at \$1,900—it would handle 100 bushels an hour.

**SPEAKERS**

Speakers included Ed Leggett, and Charlie Cook, Montrose; Don Gillis, Halifax; Pat Koons, Toronto and Charlie Mills, department of industry, Ottawa.

Farmers with suitable grain storage bins could cut the costs in that they would not have to purchase them, but the bins would have to have raised floors that are perforated, so the hot air could be blown into the grain and then be able to rise to the top of the grain.

**NEW ON ISLAND**

This sort of thing is new in the Maritimes, and on the island, said Mr. Linkletter.

Don Stewart, agricultural officer, Canada department of agriculture, Charlottetown, said moisture level of grain for permanent storage would run about 9.5 percent. For over-winter storage it should be not over 15 percent. Mr. Stewart said he has seen barley with a moisture content as high as 25 percent.

## City Council In Lengthy Session

In his monthly report to the Charlottetown City Council Monday night, Chief of Police F.S. Webster stated that 117 arrests were made during November with 110 convictions.

## Minister Is Guest Speaker

**Industry and Fisheries Minister Miller** said Monday that Industrial Enterprises Corp., the Province's Industrial Promotion Agency, should not neglect Prince Edward Island's Primary Industries.

Mr. Miller told the Agency's first annual meeting the Government fully supports its attempts to encourage industrial development on the island, but it should not concentrate on secondary industry alone.

"I would suggest that you also consider assistance in fisheries, agriculture and tourism, especially where employment is a factor," Mr. Miller said.
