Little Ernie Harper Drowned While Bathing at Belvedere. This morning, Ernest Harper, the ten year old son of Mr. William W. Harper, carpenter, of this city, and his sister went out to Belvedere berry-picking. Shortly before noon Ernie left his sister and went out swimming, starting across the creek. When some distance over he began calling out that he was drowning, and two boys named Lawler and Egan who were on the town side of the creek, went out to him and for some time succeeded in keeping him afloat. But the effort to save the boy was too great for the limited strength of the two lads and the unfortunate young fellow went down.

A boy ran to town to let Mr. Harper know what had happened his son, and on his way met Dr. James Warburton and told him what had occurred. The Dr. made all haste to the scene of the sad occurrence and swam out to where he was told the boy had sunk. But the water was so muddy that he could not see anything, and returned to the shore. A few minutes later he was notified that the boy had made another trip to where the boy was last seen. After the water cleared somewhat, he saw the body lying on the bottom, and transferred it to the bank, and thence to the shore. The body was subsequently removed to the residence of the boy's parents, Fitzroy Street east. The deceased was a great favorite with those who knew him.
