14 DIE IN STAMPEDE
SEOUL (Reuters)—Fourteen persons, including 12 old women and a two-year-old boy, were killed and 54 others seriously injured Tuesday in a stampede outside a sports stadium at Kwangju, South Korea. A crowd of about 30,000, packed round the stadium where the annual national games are being held, tried to force its way in after the gates were closed. The main gate collapsed.

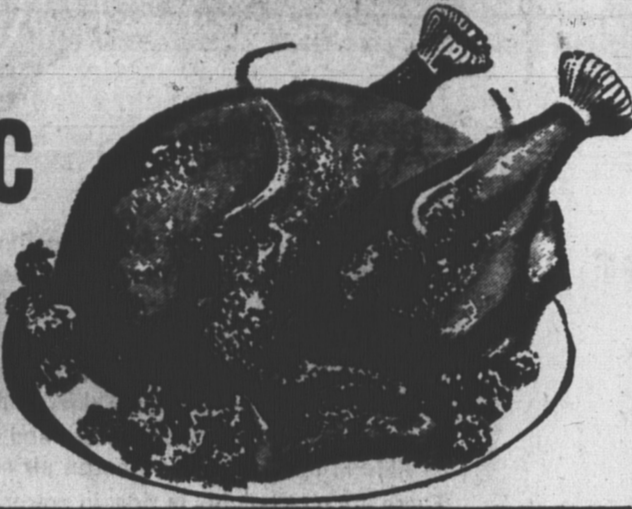
