The official opening and naming of Dr. J. Henry Blanchard Hall (better known as the New Residence) occurred last Friday, September 20. Dr. Blanchard, who died in 1968, was a well known Acadian historian who spent more than 50 years of his life teaching in P.E.I. He first

taught at St. Dunstan's University, then at Prince of Wales College where he was vice principle from 1938 to 1948.

The unveiling ceremony was attended by about 75 people, including the Blanchard family, Mr. Baker, Mr. C. Sinclair Trainor, the deans and many interested students.
