## Attack Proposed On Retardation

During the past year, he explained, he had visited Great Britain, the United States and various parts of Canada, and there he had met and talked with governmental health officials, volunteers in national societies engaged in retardation work, and professional workers in university research projects. On every hand he had heard the same theme voiced: More must be known of what appeared to be successful.

He then challenged the practical divisions of the association to undertake the task of solving the questions that must be answered, and described it as a "centennial crusade" because by 1967, if every province co-operated, pilot projects could be producing the answers.
