## Montreal Stocks

MONTREAL (CP)—Prices moved to higher ground in active trading at the close of the stock market Thursday.

High spots included Canadian Dredge, up 2 1/2 points in active trade at 22 1/2, International Paper, up 2 at a new high of 106 and Ford, up 1 1/2 at 118 Seargans at 38 and Canada Car at a new high of 24 1/2, advanced 1 1/2.

On the downside were Walker, off 1 1/2 to 70 1/2, Hudson Bay, off 1/2 to 61 1/2 and General Dynamics, off 1/2 to 59 1/2. Industrial Acceptance, ex-dividend today, was 1/2 easier at 37.

Mines moved ahead. Features included Canadian Collieries, up \$1.95, Quebec Lithium, up \$1, Steep Rock, up 50 cents, Beaucage, up 20 cents, Canadian Metals, up 19 cents and Nama, up 15 cents. Burnt Hill was 20 cents lower at \$4.40.

The stock exchange's closing averages show banks up 0.16 at 46.80, utilities up 0.4 at 126.8, industrials up 2.0 at a new high of 275.8, combined up 1.5 at a new high of 225.2, papers up 4.22 at a new high of 1390.49 and golds up 0.94 at \$2.61.

## New York Stocks

NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market shook free from the doldrums Thursday and managed a modest advance.

Demand broadened to include most major divisions and encompassed some that have been neglected of late.

The stocks did well along with motors, rubbers, farm implements, aircrafts, distillers, chemicals, motion pictures, building materials, and utilities.

Prices throughout the list were up 1 to 3 points frequently.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was up 50c at \$185.50. Industrial component was ahead \$1, rails were down 20 cents, and utilities up 20 cents.

Business amounted to 2,610,000 shares, best total in three weeks.

Canadian issues were mostly higher. McIntyre added 2 1/2. Distillers Seagram gained 1 1/2. International Nickel advanced one point and Canadian Pacific and Dome Mines both added 1/2. Hiram Walker was off one point.

On the American stock exchange Giant Yellowknife and Royaltie Oil both slipped 1/2 and Lake Shore gained 1/2.

## Toronto Stocks

TORONTO (CP)—The stock market moved strongly ahead Thursday with all major sections sharing in the advance.

Continued heavy demand for lower priced mining issues pushed trading along at the fastest pace in more than two weeks.
