VICE-PRESIDENT EXTERNAL: The VP External shall: -Assume the duties and responsibilities of the President in the President's absence or incapacity - Perform such research activities as may be assigned or required by the Union on behalf of its students - Act as a liaison between the Union and all groups outside the University -Be a member of Senate - Perform such other duties as required -Be responsible for Canadian Federation of Students on campus.

VICE-PRESIDENT INTERNAL: The VP Internal shall: -Oversee all Student Union sponsored events, and oversee all suborganization events occurring in the Union building -Engage the services of entertainers as required -Oversee the activities of the Panther Lounge Manager and the Campus Police Chief -Be
