IN MEMORIAM

WILLIAM ALLAN CAMPBELL

The many friends of William Allan Campbell will regret to hear that he passed away on Tuesday August 7th at his home in Revere, Mass. following a short illness.

Mr. Campbell was born at Alberton, Prince Edward Island in 1876, a son of the late Ewen Campbell and his wife Tamer MacKendrick.

Twenty years ago he moved to Revere, Mass., where he became manager of the A. and P. Store, later the proprietor of Campbell's Market on Beech Street. He was a devoted member of the First Methodist Church and Superintendent of the Sunday School. Active in all good work in connection with the community where he lived, he will be greatly missed but most of all in the home where his love of family and friends was always so evident.
