PEANUT CANDY SUNDAE SAUCE Crush 1 lb. of peanut plank

and add 1/2 cup each of 12 caramels and 1/2 undiluted evaporated milk or half 1/2 cup soft butter. Blend or beat longer in a double boiler.

Says Church Is Swinging Toward Rome

LONDON (AP) - The Archbishop of Canterbury, Dr. Michael Ramsey, listened in silence today when the House of Commons passed a bill to allow the church to accept the new measures of the Vatican.

There can be no possible doubt that these changes are being made step by step in order that the church may move further toward Rome in its policies.

The measure was approved with only Lord Alexander dissenting.

Lord Alexander, who is connected with the upper house, opposed approval of a measure passed by the church assembly to amend an old law prescribing that church altars must be made of wood and that the church must have some Anglican altars of stone and never moved.

Lord Alexander said that he was not in favor of the measure because it would be a step toward Rome in its policies.
