Mr. Blake's Letter.

To the utterances of the Honorable Edward Blake the people of Canada will ever turn a respectful ear. They may not all agree with him, but they cannot withhold the respect due to a great intellect, and to a man who has followed his convictions regardless of personal or party expediencies.

He evidently regards annexation as the ultimate destiny of Canada, but concludes rightly that the people are not ready to consider such a step.

Mr. Blake's idea on the trade question may be briefly stated as follows: He thinks free trade with the world and reciprocal free trade with the United States the ideal arrangement.

It is impracticable, because the Canadian policy for the last thirteen years will necessitate for an indefinite time the raising of an enormous revenue by high duties on imports.
