Campers In Large Numbers Expected To Use Facilities

Upwards of 19,000 campers are expected to make use of the facilities available in Prince Edward Island's national park this season, according to a forecast made yesterday by the park superintendent, E.J. Kipping. Mr. Kipping said that 14,476 tourists had camped in the park during 1958, and indications pointed to an increase this year of possibly 30 per cent. In 1957 only 10,275 campers were registered. With a total 6,891 using its facilities during 1956, and 4,928 in 1957, the Stanhope encampment continues to be the most popular with the "do-it-yourself" visitors. During this period registration at the two other park encampments were as follows: Cavendish-5,659 in 1958 and 4,007 in 1957. Brackley-1,926 in 1958 and 1,350 in 1957.
