Jap Trade Mission
To Visit Canada
 TOKYO, (AP)—Canadian Ambassador Robert W. Mayhew said Tuesday the forthcoming visit of a 19-man Japanese trade mission to Canada would be one step toward placing trade between Japan and Canada "on a sound basis."

Fourteen members of the Japanese trade delegation will leave Tokyo May 31 via Canadian Pacific Airlines to attend the sixth international trade fair at Toronto. They will be joined by five others in Vancouver.

U. S. Steel Report
 CLEVELAND (AP)—The magazine Steel says indications point to further gains in steel production during June.

May production is expected to average about 70.5 per cent of capacity, the highest month since February's 74.3, and June probably will be "a little busier," Steel said. March production was 69 and April 68.2.

The magazine's weekly summary of the metalworking industry added: "June could well be a pretty good month. Summer vacations and hot weather don't start slowing things down that early. Good weather promotes the use of steel among such heavy-hitting customers as the construction industry."

"Threat of a steelworkers' strike could inspire a buying spree. Demands growing out of the increasingly tight international situation could begin appearing."

Already, Steel said, some new defence business has come in. The Midvale Co. of Philadelphia received a \$3,321,000 army contract for mass production of high-explosive shells for atomic cannon.

"Contracts such as these," Steel continued, "may impart some strength to the steel bar market."
