Investment By Americans Slowed Abroad

WASHINGTON (AP) - The pace of United States private investment abroad slowed early in 1962 after increasing sharply last year as commerce department reports. The department said here direct investment in foreign business is running behind the 1961 pace, due to reduced growth in Europe, unstable conditions in Latin America, and economic difficulties in Canada. Sharp declines in most foreign stock markets slowed investment in foreign stock while sales of foreign bonds in the United States also were relatively low. At the end of 1961 private U.S. assets and investments abroad were valued at nearly \$65,000,000, having grown by more than \$5,000,000 during the year. Capital outflows reached a peak of nearly \$4,000,000 in 1961, exceeding the previous year's mark by \$100,000,000.
